Enrollment (392 students)

- Racial demographics were presented
- 10% special ed; 22% on free/reduced lunch
- Gained 8 new students in Dec (newcomers, homeless & highly mobile, and transfers)

Communication updates

- SMORE is now being used for school newsletters. Will work on creating an archive so caregivers can find old ones.
- Website updates are live - handbook, additional information for caregivers under "About"

Update of Families

- Some really tough family situations arose in December that were hard on staff and a reminder that many are facing more than it seems.

School Improvement Plan

- Similar to last update. Now posted on the website.
- Main change is switching professional learning communities to peer observations due to requirements for LETRS training (science of reading professional development)

Language at Northrop

- Some recent incidents highlighted for Mr Uhler the need to do more proactive work about what constitutes supportive, respectful language (and the importance of not using inappropriate, hurtful language)
- Last week, Uhler did assemblies related to the new red, yellow, green framework that students engaged well with
- Working to extend this work further with kids as their seems to be need and enthusiasm
