Final Transcripts

1. Request through Parchment NOW. Scroll down to the bottom of MHS home page and click on blue/white button that says Order Records. In Parchment, select “Hold for Grades” for your final transcript. Send only to the one school you plan to attend.
Athletes: the NCAA will also need a final transcript.
2. Make sure your Parchment profile has a personal email address not your school email address.
3. Final transcripts will not be sent until after the last week in June. You can check and see if your transcript has been sent by checking your Parchment account.
4. Currently free, if you wait to do this after August 1, it will cost you \$4.00 per transcript.

Important Reminders

- If you are attending a 4-yr University, they typically request students take a **PLACEMENT TEST** prior to course registration in the summer. You can take this at UWEC (campus choice does not matter, if you are attending a UW school), based on availability. Some schools will use your ACT scores for placement-check with your college admissions office. IF you need to register, you can do so at <https://testing.wisc.edu/centerpages/regionaltesting.html>
- If you will be attending a college in Minnesota, it is important to complete a Reciprocity Agreement to obtain a reduced tuition cost. THIS IS NOT AUTOMATIC; you will be billed “out-of-state” tuition if you do not fill this out and submit it to your school. This will save you money.
