

# Junior-Year Timeline 2025-2026

## All Year:

- Maintain your grades, activities and volunteer work. Don't join more than you can handle.
  Colleges do not count the number of activities, just the depth of your involvement.
- Do college and career research: Naviance, College Board's Big Future, Career Journeys.
- Meet with college and career representatives visiting PRHS. Ask about current majors, careers, admission requirements and scholarships. View list and sign up in <u>Naviance</u>.
- Contact colleges for open house dates or to schedule a visit. Sign up through the admission website to receive information.
- Register with a large scholarship search engine: Going Merry and/or Fastweb.
- Use Naviance or Canva to update or create your resume.
- Create an appropriate testing timeline. Attend a <u>SAT/ACT</u> workshop at PRHS.
- Register with the <u>NCAA Eligibility Center</u> if you plan on pursuing D1 or D2 intercollegiate athletics. Meet with your school counselor to check on your eligibility.
- If currently receiving Special Education support, become familiar with post-secondary <u>Special</u> <u>Education Services</u>. Contact each college/technical school's Disability Services Office for accommodation information and timeline.

#### October:

- North Pittsburgh College Fair: La Roche College on October 6, 2025.
- Attend virtual Financial Aid Night on October 16, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. View webinars here.
- Take the PSAT. Use the <u>Bluebook</u> app to prepare.

## November:December:January

- Research college majors, related careers and potential future salaries.
- Complete Pennsylvania State required Naviance CEW lessons.
- Attend College Planning Night. View past recordings.

## February:

- Attend the Pittsburgh National College Fair David L. Lawrence Convention Center. Inquire about admission requirements for both scheduling and admission.
- Review your senior year schedule with your school counselor/admission representative.
- Research summer enrichment programs. Use Naviance, <u>Teen Life</u>.

# March:

- Take the <u>SAT</u> Saturday, March 14, 2026, at PRHS. Use <u>Khan Academy</u> to prepare.
- Visit colleges during spring break or take the virtual tour online.
- Begin drafting your college essay/personal statement.

#### April:

- Take the ACT test on Saturday, April 10, 2026. Test not offered at PRHS.
- Ask two teachers, school counselor to write a letter of recommendation. Provide a resume and complete the Brag Sheet Survey in Naviance.

## May:

- AP exams
- Sat test offered on Saturday, May 2, 2026.

## **Summer Before Senior Year:**

- SAT tests offered in June, August, September. ACT tests offered in June and July.
- Attend workshops on the Common Application and Transcript/Teacher Letter of Rec.
- Review your high school transcript. Report any discrepancy.
- Update your resume.
- Compile a list of reach, target and safety schools. Use <u>Naviance</u> to access past historical data. Be sure to include application types (Early Action, Early Decision, etc.) and deadline dates.
