

# Maryville Junior High PAC

## Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, February 18, 2025

**Opening:** The regular meeting of the Maryville Junior High PAC was called to order at 11:33am on Tuesday, February 18, 2025.

### **Present:**

**Financial Report:** At the beginning of the fiscal year, an excess of \$638.89 existed in the \$3,000.00 buffer carried over from the prior year. In order to offset a deficiency in the budgeted income, this excess was reallocated to Income. As a result, total income increased to \$11,723.54.

Additionally, we exceed the budgeted amount for Misc expenses due to the reallocation of the expense for gift cards for Career Fair to this category. However, a balance remains unused in the budget for Career Fair expenses. A portion of those funds were reallocated to Misc expenses to cover the overage and the rest to the amount available for Grants resulting in a remaining balance \$1,943.05 available for Grants.

Dustin made a motion to approve the report. Kandi seconded. All were in favor.

Dustin moved to approve the minutes. Kandi seconded. All were in favor and the January minutes were approved.

**Grants:** Dustin reviewed the grants submitted for approval. An application from Dr. Hebert was time-sensitive and approved in the January meeting. The second half of grants for Mike Wise and the Academic Deans previously approved in August have been disbursed for \$385.00 and \$750.00, respectively. Pending for approval is an application from Angie Kizer for Digital Wall Clocks in the amount of \$1198.68. Dustin moved to approve the application. Beth seconded. All were in favor.

**Teacher Appreciation:** The final appreciation day will be lunch provided on May 5. This lunch is usually catered by McAlister's Deli. However, due to cost and other issues, Afton is looking into serving Mexican in celebration of Cinco de Mayo.

### **Administrative Report**

Administration in attendance: Combs, Kessler, Mullins, Wise, Nizinski, Cox, Strom

- Mr. Combs shared some recent athletic success at MJHS, including 9<sup>th</sup> grader Ellie Stanley who won the State Championship in the Women's 200 Individual Medley, and five wrestlers headed to the state competition.
- Mr. Combs said that the school would be replacing the flooring in the upstairs classrooms over summer break. Also, he reported that improvements were coming to the exterior of the main building that would modernize its appearance.

- Mr. Wise reported that five field trips are planned for the Ready Graduate program: Cirrus Aircraft, Oak Ridge Enhanced Technology and Training Center, Amazon, Beehive Industries Advanced Manufacturing and a combined trip to the Police Academy, jail, and court. He said that the program is open for a Lunch & Learn visit in April if has a recommendation.
