Minutes:

1. Mr. Ingham welcomed everyone and thanked them for a great year.
 - a. All Council Members will be rolling off in SY25-26 and are all welcome to reapply
 - b. Changes will be coming for next year and we are looking at adding students to the school council
2. Mr. Ingham showed WHS Updates
 - a. The SY24-25 End of the Year Calendar
 - i. Senior meeting will be held on April 11th to cover end of year expectations
 - b. STEM Program Updates – Year 1
 - i. Last year, EV Fair, City of Woodstock, Presentation to City Council on EV Chargers, Engineering Real World Design Challenge, Changed Pathway from Engineering to Drafting and Design
 - c. Year 2 after Cogna Certification
 - i. Expanding project to Vermiculture and Greenhouse
 - d. Facility Updates – Current and Summer of 2025

Mr. Ingham stated that input is very valuable.

Mr. Johnson shared that Woodstock is STEM Program certified, not school-certified. Woodstock will be adding more pathways every year. Ms. Bennett shared that parents do not necessarily know the difference between the two distinctions. Mr. Ingham discussed that the Superintendent is changing how the budget is more closely being spent on the classroom and will be available to order materials and have them available when school starts. Ms. Bennett shared best practices that she has observed from

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other school districts. Mr. Ingham discussed supports that will be woven into the curriculum next year to assist students who may not be on grade level. Ms. Baglio added that Latin is the language of STEM and the addition of Latin at Woodstock Middle will be a great addition to the curriculum.
