GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Summer athletic camps are open to all high school students and completely voluntary.
- FALL SPORTS: If necessary, summer tryouts will be held after the conclusion of summer camps, and prior to the start of school.
- WINTER/SPRING SPORTS: If necessary, summer tryouts may be held for determination of first quarter PE class enrollment. Final team tryout dates will be announced at the beginning of the school year.
- A team designation used during the summer period does not determine the team level selection during the season.
