

# EISD ELEMENTARY SUMMER ACADEMY 2025

**Fundamental classes in reading and math** will be offered for students who were in grades K-5 during the 2024-2025 school year. The program is designed to support **students who need additional help or time mastering grade level objectives**.

The classes, which will be located at Cedar Creek Elementary, 3301 Pinnacle Road, will be offered in two separate sessions daily, Monday through Thursday, beginning Monday, June 2nd, for a period of four weeks, ending on Thursday, June 26th (no school on Thursday, June 19). Students may enroll in either Reading, Math, or both classes. Instruction will be based on individual student profiles provided by the student's current classroom teacher. Profiles will identify the course objectives needing reinforcement.

# **2025 EISD ELEMENTARY SUMMER ACADEMY**

The 2025 EISD Elementary Summer Academy classes are **fundamental reading and math classes** for students *who are currently in grades* K - 5 *during this 2024-2025 school year.* The classes will be offered in two separate sessions daily, **Monday through Thursday**.

The program is designed to support **students who need additional help** mastering grade level objectives. Instruction will be based on individual student profiles provided by the student's current classroom teacher. Profiles will identify the course objectives that need additional reinforcement.

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

### **CONFIRMATION**

Classes will be offered if ten or more students enroll in a grade level. If a class level does not have enough students enrolled, you will be notified either by email or telephone prior to the beginning of summer classes.

### **TUITION REFUND POLICY**

Deadline for registration is **Friday, April 25, 2025**. <u>No refunds will be given to students who withdraw</u> <u>after May 16, 2025</u>. Refunds will be mailed following Eanes ISD business department guidelines. Under no circumstances will there be cash refunds. Tuition will be refunded for those classes that do not make due to lack of enrollment.

# ATTENDANCE

Regular school attendance guidelines will apply. Students will be met each day, prior to class, to gather and walk to their class with their teacher. Being on time is important, as stragglers will cause a delay in the start time for classes. If, for any reason a student must leave class, she/he must check out through the summer school principal's office.

# **SNACKS**

Students enrolled in both reading and math are encouraged to bring nutritional snacks from home. Students will be allowed to eat snacks during this break between subjects.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation will not be provided by the district. Families will need to provide their own transportation for their child(ren) to attend summer school.

#### **DRESS CODE**

Students should dress in a manner that is clean and neat and that will not be a health or safety hazard to themselves or others. Dress code standards for the regular school year will apply.

#### **CONDUCT**

Students are expected to comply with all elementary school conduct requirements outlined in the *Student Code of Conduct Handbook*.
