The **Power Pumper** grant allows students with special needs the chance to move and propel "ride on" equipment on their own. The Power Pumper has proven to give therapeutic benefits including bilateral coordination, extremity development, self-esteem and confidence, as well as increased endu

Total amount awarded in classroom grants during 2018 was \$80,277.91!



Through the Empowering Women Through Self-Defense Including Dynamic Simulation grant, Red Oak ISD female students and staff are educated on decision-making responsibility, dependency on self, and self-realization of physical power. The program teaches awareness, risk reduction, risk recognition, avoidance, and physical defense strategies.

The program develops self-confidence for teenage girls, and provides Professional Development credits for staff. Each participant obtains strategies and skills to protect themselves if ever attacked and to be able to survive an abduction. This is

very beneficial, particularly for the high school girls who will be entering college in the near future. Participants completed evaluations following the final class. The program was rated "Excellent" by a majority of participants, with comments such as "Loved it", "Fun", "Learned some great tips", and Highly recommend it."

"I am very proud of the equipment that was purchased through the Red Oak ISD Education Foundation Grant to enhance the R.A.D. Empowering Women Through Self-Defense program. The targets and pads provide a "hands on" experience for the participants. The instructors demonstrate, explain, and do repetition when teaching the self-defense techniques. But the actual impact when the participants practice with the pads and targets becomes a life changing experience. That is when the confidence and physical power become evident in the ladies. It is a very gratifying experience for all of us in the program."

Inaugural Year for ROHS Writing Center Review

"The 2018-19 inaugural year in the Writing Center at ROHS was a wonderful success! Tutors applied for positions, and thirteen were chosen to train during Talon Time the first five weeks of school on how to effectively lead and peer coach all writers, all levels. Talon Time remained a critical "need" time throughout the year. Regardless if students attended for intervention or just some extra tips on college admissions essays or composing research papers, tutors assisted with content, organization, grammar, and citations. They truly mentored their peers on embracing the "process" that writing is, not just a product for a grade.



At least five tutors served during each Talon Time throughout the year, seeing at least one but usually two tutees—sometimes both at once! These sessions supported instructors, as they could assist other students and still follow-up with those who attended the Writing Center. Additionally, the Center was open twice per week after school. We saw over fifty students during those after school times, just between October 15 and April 1 alone. More than fifteen students had multiple visits. Combined with Talon Time, the Center served approximately 160 students—this is amazing for a first year, completely peer-run resource! That amounts to almost fifty additional hours of writing resource time provided for students this year!!

We are currently accepting new application for WC tutors, as several of our amazing team members are graduating. The tutors themselves are moving forward with new leadership skills, stronger writing abilities, and looking towards continued efforts with helping peers in their next steps (whether college-bound or career-track).

I cannot thank the Education Foundation enough for the support provided in obtaining training materials and other resources necessary to start this Writing Center. We hope to see it continue to grow in 2019-20 and look forward to that next chapter!"
