### **Texas Mobile Imaging:**

Jerry Hancock came to give us a presentation on their mobile imaging. They have worked with many other school districts within Region 11. They have helped many with early cancer diagnoses that had no symptoms. This service offers ultrasound screenings on vascular, vital organ, AFIB and bone density.

Screening dates are available Monday-Saturday from 8am-6pm. Once dates are confirmed, flyers will be sent out to staff. Texas Mobile Imaging will set up at multiple schools for easy access. Staff will be able to set an appointment time that works for their schedule. The screenings offered are not covered by insurance companies until symptoms are shown. This offer will help with early detection at a low cost for staff and immediate family. Results will be received by mail in 3-4 weeks.

### **Phoenix House:**

Marie Brown came to give us a presentation on addiction treatment for young adults, 13-18 years old. Vaping and edibles are the main concern with elementary students. Phoenix House is available to do in school presentations for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and up on the severity of addiction.

Phoenix House offers outpatient and residential treatment options. Treatment can last 90-120 days. Male and females are welcome in to their program and are kept separate at all times. The patients will attend group sessions and attend AA/NA/12 step if necessary. Full time nurse and a Psychiatrist are on site to help with meds and mental health to those needed.

Marie would like Red Oak ISD to keep Phoenix House in mind and to share their mission with others. Information will be shared with the counselors and nursing staff.
