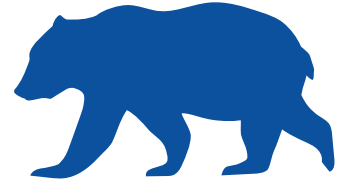

IMMUNIZATION CLINIC

THURSDAY, APRIL 17 | 4 - 6:30 P.M.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Parent/Guardian must be present to complete paperwork & bring all immunization records
- Texas Department of Health requires all students to have all required immunizations prior to the start of school
- Updated records must be provided to school nurse in August.

Prevents Disease Spread – Protects children and school community from contagious diseases like measles, mumps and whooping cough

Keeps Kids in School – Reduces risk of outbreaks that can lead to absences and disruptions in learning

Protects Vulnerable Individuals – Helps safeguard those who cannot be vaccinated due to medical conditions


Immunization Clinic

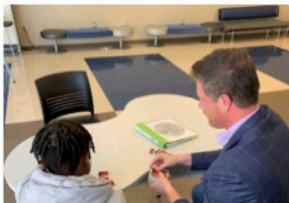
