



## **Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST)**

is a two-day interactive workshop in suicide first aid. ASIST teaches participants to recognize when someone may have thoughts of suicide and work with them to create a plan that will support their immediate safety. ASIST helps participants become more willing, ready, and able to intervene with someone who has thoughts of suicide. ASIST is also proven to reduce suicidality for those with thoughts of suicide.
