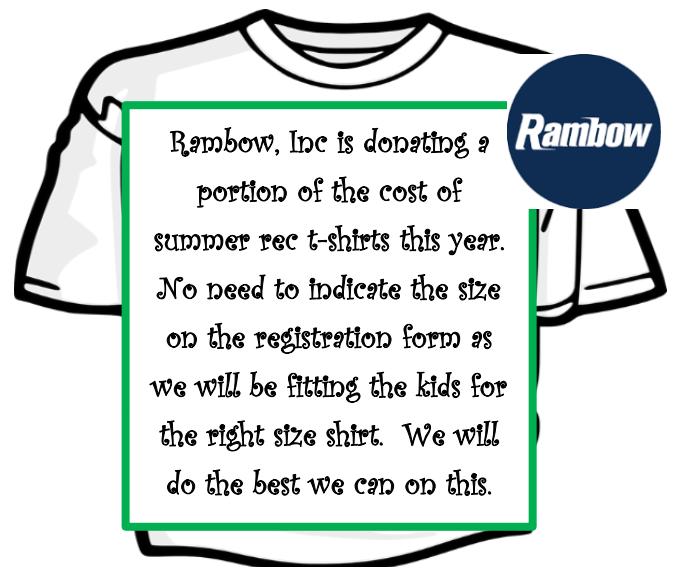
# MACCRA Y 2025 SUMMER REC

## REMINDERS & CHANGES

- \* We will be joining the newly formed MRVED Summer Rec league. We are excited to be playing some new schools/towns. Game Day schedules will be handed out the first week of summer rec.
- \* Summer rec will all be in Raymond again this summer, **except t-ball will be in both Raymond and Clara City**. T-ball will be from 8:00 – 8:45 on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- \* Shuttle busses will be provided to and from Maynard and Clara City. Schedule on summer rec page.
- \* Use the **"current"** 2024-25 grade of your child for registration for all activities listed in the booklet.
- \* Summer rec is **RAIN or SHINE!** If the weather is bad, we will move indoors in the Raymond Event Center, former Raymond school, until the weather improves. For T-Ball in Clara City, we will move into the HS gym if the weather is bad. The practice times will be the same. If a game is cancelled, we will have summer rec during normal practice times – rain or shine.
- \* **Little Cubs** will be for girls and boys that are completing **kindergarten and first grade this year**. Kids will have the choice of hitting off a batting tee or live pitching. They will have practice Monday through Thursday – not Fridays. On Wednesdays, Little Cubs will have a game instead of practice. We may line up some games with RCW and YME, also. Teams will be randomly picked, and similar Level A rules will apply for the games.
- \* We will be using REMIND exclusively to communicate to parents about summer rec information.

## Important Information

- **Start Date: Monday, June 9<sup>th</sup>.**
- We are joining a new MRVED Summer Rec league that includes Dawson-Boyd, Lac Qui Parle, MACCRAY, Montevideo, RCW, and YME.
  - There will be game days for the different levels-Tuesdays for Minors and Thursdays for Majors.
  - Game days bring three or four schools together at one location and teams will have two games.
- We encourage both girls and boys to sign up for our ball program. Teams are a mix of both.
- No summer rec on Juneteenth (June 19<sup>th</sup>) and the week of July 4<sup>th</sup>.
- The fee for Minors and Majors is \$60 per participant if paid by **Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup> - \$70 after that date.**
- The fee for Little Cubs is \$50.00 if paid by **Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup> - \$60 after that date.**
- Maximum fee will be for three children – *free for 4<sup>th</sup> or more children. Note on registration form.*
- There are limited scholarships and preference will be given to requests made by May 16<sup>th</sup>.

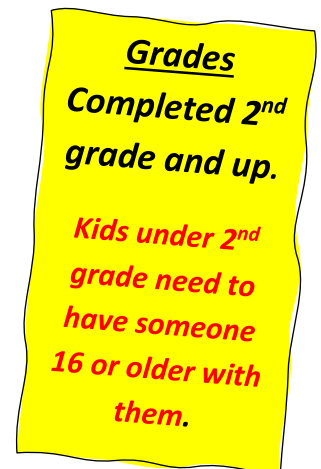

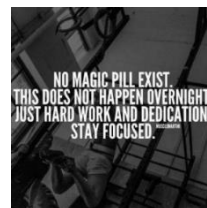
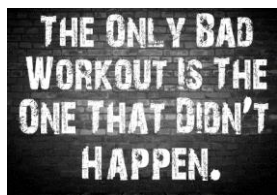
