6 foot fencing placed around the perimeter of playgrounds and property.

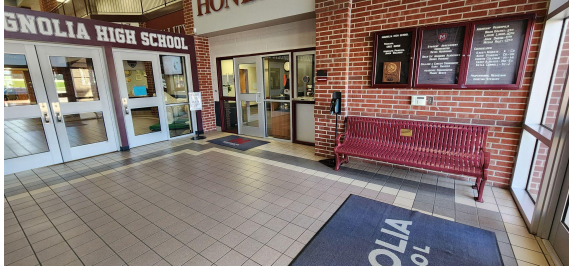
Iron fencing toward the front of the campus.

Chain Link fencing with slats around the perimeter area towards the back of properties and/or along major roads.

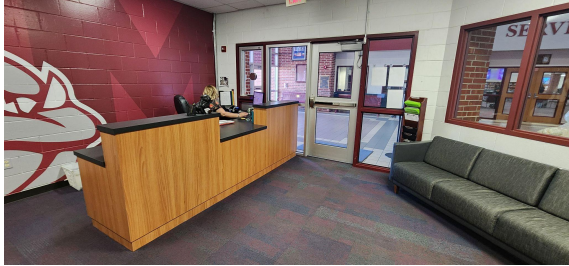
The purpose of fencing is to prevent ease of access.

# Door Access (Keypads)



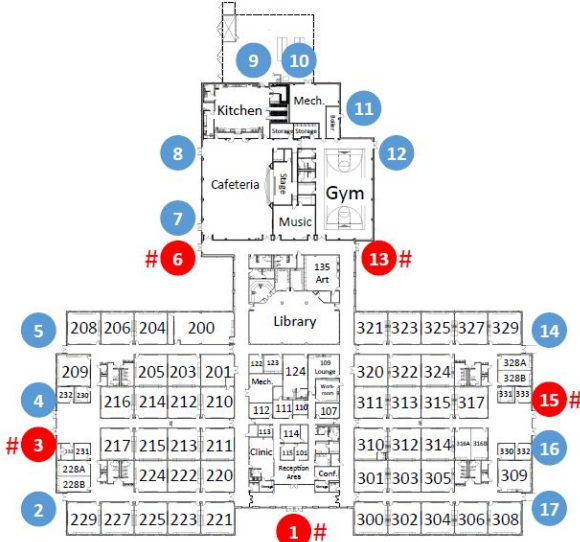
All campuses now have Door Access Keypads on certain doors to provide staff the ability to enter the building without the need of an exterior key.

# Door Numbers & Updated Maps



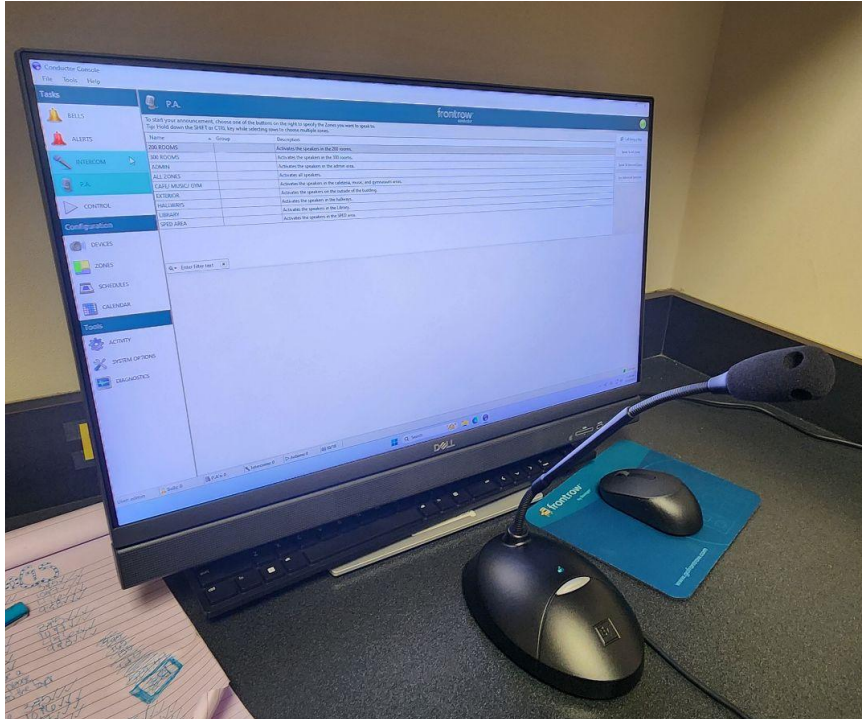
All campus exterior doors have been numbered and move clockwise around the building.
