



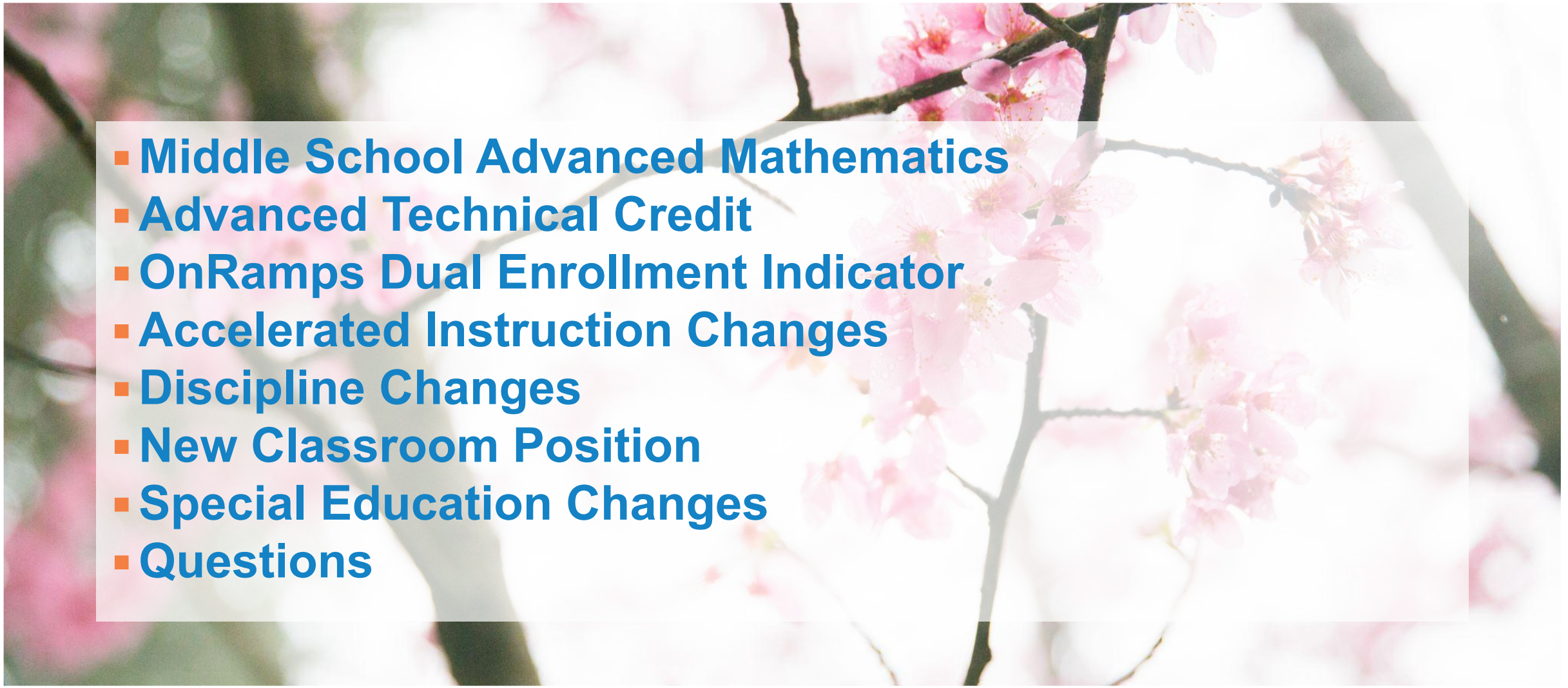

Middle School Advanced Mathematics

- During the 88th legislative session, SB 2124 was passed, which added that each school district and open-enrollment charter school should develop an advanced mathematics program for middle school students that is designed to enable those students to enroll in Algebra I in eighth grade. (Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §74.2101)
- One new descriptor will be added to the **StudentCharacteristic** (C344) descriptor table to collect in the **PEIMS Fall Submission** if a student is enrolled in an advanced mathematics program.

OnRamps Dual Enrollment Background

- The TEA Performance Reporting Division receives student-level information about **OnRamps college course completion**, course credit, and credit hours directly from the University of Texas at Austin. TEA cannot determine the secondary course credit given to a student by the local education agency (LEA).
- One new data element, **OnRampsDualEnrollmentIndicator** (E3120), will be added to the **CourseTranscript** Entity and collected in the **PEIMS Summer and Extended Year Submissions** for TEA to determine which secondary courses align with specific OnRamps courses.

Data Element Reporting Requirements

DR1

CollegeCreditHours (E1081) indicate the number of college hours a student earned for the completion of a dual credit course.

If a student completes a dual credit course and does not pass the course, then the *CollegeCreditHours* will be reported as 0.

If a student completes an OnRamps Dual Enrollment course and does not pass the course, then the *CollegeCreditHours* will be reported as 0.

When a course is reported as eligible to receive dual credit, be cautious to avoid duplicating the college credit hours earned across multiple course sections. College credit hours should only be reported when a student completes and passes a one semester course (*CourseSequence* D0 (Single Semester Dual Credit Course)) or the last part of a multi-part course (*CourseSequence* D2 (Second Half of a Two Semester Dual Credit Course), D5 (Last Third of a Three Semester Dual Credit Course), or D9 (Last Fourth of a Four Semester Dual Credit Course)).

Note: A campus may report *CollegeCreditHours* for students who complete an OnRamps course through the University of Texas at Austin.

DualCreditIndicator (E1011) indicates whether the student was eligible to receive both high school and college credit for a college course.

Advanced Placement courses reported on the StudentAcademicRecord Entity cannot be reported as dual credit unless the course has been approved as an AP® course by the College Board through the AP® Course Audit. A College Board-approved AP® course must adhere to the AP® course descriptions and be approved through the AP® Course Audit. This means the college instructor must have submitted their course syllabus and have received approval in advance.

Note: Do not report *DualCreditIndicator* for students who complete an OnRamps course through the University of Texas at Austin.

SummerSchoolIndicator (E3091) indicates the course completed by a student was completed during the summer (between school years).

DropoutRecoveryCourseCompletion (E3097) indicates if the course completed by a student in a dropout recovery education program under TEC §29.081 was completed in person or remotely.

OnRampsDualEnrollmentIndicator (E3120) indicates that the student has completed an OnRamps dual enrollment course.

OnRamps is an innovative dual enrollment program coordinated by the University of Texas at Austin (reported in Submissions 3 and 4 only).

OnRamps courses cannot be reported with the *DualCreditIndicator*.

Note: A campus may report *CollegeCreditHours* for students who complete an OnRamps course through the University of Texas at Austin.

Accelerated Instruction Changes

Accelerated Instruction Background

- In the 2024-2025 PEIMS Summer Submission, TEA will begin collecting data to identify the **accelerated instruction** provided by an LEA to a particular student.
- Texas Administrative Code, Section 104.1001, was adopted, which approved **Ratio Waiver List (RWL)** products. These products use automated, computerized, or other augmented methods of instruction, which LEAs can use in place of some or all of the required individual or group instruction.
- The Texas Tutoring Supports Division has determined that it is necessary to know which students use a product from the **RWL** for their accelerated instruction.

AcceleratedInstructionSet Common Type

- One new data element, **RatioWaiverListProductUsed** (E3121), will be added to the **AcceleratedInstructionSet** common type in the **StudentEducationOrganizationAssociation** Entity and collected beginning in the 2025-2026 PEIMS Summer Submission.
