# Seniors interested in applying for financial aid for college:

<u>FAFSA</u> opens on December 1. Students need to complete the FAFSA (regardless of their financial situation) to be eligible for free tuition if they will be attending LCC full time. Both a <u>student and parent FSA ID</u> must be created before you can submit the FAFSA. For full financial aid benefits, students should submit their completed FAFSA by March 1, 2025.

Let's make this year's yearbook one to remember!


### **IMPORTANT 24-25 NHS DATES**
