# OKEMOS HIGH SCHOOL COMMUNITY,

This spring (March 31–April 18), we will administer the BASC-3 Behavioral and Emotional Screening System to assess student strengths and areas for growth. Students in grades 3–12 (ages 8+) will complete a brief selfrating screener (5–15 minutes). This is not a diagnostic tool but one of many data points used to inform school-based support. Results will be analyzed within four weeks, and staff will not respond immediately to elevated risk scores. If you have concerns about your student, please contact the building counselor. No action is required if you consent to your student's participation. If you would prefer that your student NOT participate in the BASC screener, please complete this Google Form to opt-out by Friday, March 28.


