BACKGROUND INFORMATION

As part of the 2022 Bond, PfISD Technology Services is set to continue the upgrade and replacement of audio/visual classroom projectors.

Given the quantity of replacements across elementary campuses, these projector replacements will be divided into two phases. By doing so, there will be minimal disruption to instruction and provides for vendor products and services to be readily available. To prepare for the second phase of this project, a request for proposal (RFP) was released, encouraging vendors to bid on hardware and services for the replacement of projectors and whiteboards across the following 8 elementary campuses:

Five bids were received and are listed in Score and Rank order:

CCS Presentation Systems (CCS) has proposed the second lowest price and the highest overall ranking. CCS has also provided PfISD with AV solutions and services for various projects including projector replacements at the middle school campuses. A contract with CCS for projector replacements at the campuses listed above is being recommended for Board approval.

The requested amount includes an additional 25% due to potential federal tariffs.
