Partnership with Third Future Schools

Third Future Schools (TFS) began operating Fehl-Price ES, Jones-Clark ES, and Smith MS at the start of the 2023-2024 school year as a strategic partnership designed to support the campuses through innovative programming and additional funding to improve school performance. The partnership was originally set to continue through June 30, 2026.





Partnership with Third Future Schools

The partnership with Beaumont ISD and Third Future Schools has been successful in improving student outcomes at these campuses; however, Third Future Schools has decided to conclude the partnership early on June 30, 2025.

Beaumont ISD will resume full operation of all three campuses beginning the 2025-2026 school year.





February - April Transition Timeline

February 2025

- Third Future Schools made Beaumont ISD aware of its intent to end the partnership June 30, 2025, one year early.
- Beaumont ISD immediately began assembling committees to address the logistics of resuming full operation of the three campuses, as well as began the process to secure effective leadership for all three campuses. Leaders are expected to be in place on or before May 1, 2025.

March 2025

- Beaumont ISD Human Resources department began meeting with current schools' staff, in an effort to recruit and maintain a stable staff on each of the campuses.
- Each department began meeting with personnel of TFS to address transition action steps.

April 2025

- Summer School plans are being finalized.
- Human Resources is conducting On-Boarding Events for current TFS staff members.
- Middle School students complete course requests to build their schedules for next year.
- Athletics, fine arts, and other departments are continuing to complete necessary steps to ensure all students have access to Beaumont ISD opportunities for the 2025 - 2026 school year.



Leadership/Staffing for the 2025 - 2026 School Year

The BISD team is conducting interviews to identify high performing leaders to lead each of the three campuses starting the 2025 - 2026 school year. Principal and assistant principals, along with the remainder of the leadership teams, including counselors, and other support staff, will be named once a leader is in place.

BISD Human Resources has conducted On - Boarding Events for all three campuses in an effort to retain as many employees as possible on each of the three campuses.





What to Expect Next Year

- All three campuses, Smith MS, Fehl Price and Jones Clark ES will all be staffed with a high - performing leadership team and a staff prepared to serve all students.
- If your child qualifies for bus transportation, there will be transportation to and from your child's campus.
- Your children will follow a traditional school schedule, with eight periods at Smith MS, and either self contained or departmentalized classes at the elementary schools.
- Your child will have the opportunity to participate in available elective courses on his/her campus.
- Your child will be expected to follow all policies and procedures in place to ensure a safe and secure learning environment.
