Wingate University's nationally accredited MBA evening program has been serving Charlotte area professionals since 1991. The MBA Program is located in the Neu Building on the Wingate Main Campus in Wingate, NC. Our MBA Program is offered throughout the year during weekday evenings and combines superior academic quality with affordable tuition. *Our MBA courses are offered via remote-live-online and in-person delivery based on student preference (ie. students may elect to take classes remote-live-online, in-person, or a combination of both in-person and live-online at their discretion).*

MBA Curriculum

The MBA curriculum consists of 36 credits which includes 12 three-credit courses. It is divided into two components: core courses (30 credits) and concentration courses (6 credits). Core courses cover the complete range of business disciplines and serve as the general management foundation for the program. Concentration courses provide added depth and relevance in specific areas of emphasis that connect to student career goals and professional interests. The five areas of concentration include: Project Management, Data Analytics, Health Care Management, Corporate Innovation, and General Management.

Prerequisite Course for Non-Business Majors – Business 500

Wingate offers a unique one semester prerequisite course (Business 500) for non-business majors or for those who require some or all of the business prerequisites. This fast track prep course satisfies all of the prerequisites for the MBA program in only one semester and facilitates rapid entry into the program. Although Business 500 is only offered in the fall, it is possible for students to begin the MBA Program in the preceding spring or summer by taking certain MBA courses that are not prerequisite-based. These students then take the applicable modules of Business 500 in the following fall.

Course Sequence

Classes meet on weekday evenings with the ability to commence your studies during any semester (fall, spring, and summer). Take advantage of the program's on-going flexibility to sequence courses around your schedule so you can complete the program in only two to three years based on your professional goals.

Tuition*

\$4,380 Business 500 Prerequisite Course (\$1,095 per module as applicable; offered during fall semester)

\$730 per MBA credit hour

\$2,190 per MBA course

\$26,280 total program cost with no BUS 500 (12 courses x \$2,190 per MBA course; BUS 500 courses are extra)

\$30,660 total program cost including all of BUS 500 (\$26,280 for MBA courses + \$4,380 for all of BUS 500)

For students who receive assistance through their company's tuition reimbursement program, tuition payments are deferred until the end of each semester, which can save out-of-pocket expenses.
