## GUIDELINES FOR SOUTH FOUNTAIN PIONEERS SCHOLARSHIP (Young Farmers Organization)

#### ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Graduates of Fountain Central High School, Covington High School and Attica High School are eligible (male or female).
- 2. Applicants must plan on a course of study resulting in a major in Agriculture or
- 3. Applicants planning a 4-year course of study or other post-secondary education (vocational school) will be considered.

#### **AWARDS**

- 1. There will be a monetary amount awarded annually. This amount will be told
- 2. The award may be distributed as follows:
  - A. The full amount may be awarded to one (1) student.
  - B. Or the amount may be divided between two (2) or more deserving students.
- 3. The final number of recipients and the amounts of awards will be at the discretion of the scholarship committee.

- 3. Applications are available at the school Guidance Office.
- 4. An application deadline (to Guidance Office) is April 1.
- 5. Awards will be made at the annual Senior Awards Night.
- 6. Awards will be made directly to the student/institution.
- 7. The scholarship committee will be composed of members of the South Fountain Pioneers Organization. The scholarship committee will have the final decision on all matters concerning the scholarship program.
