INTERVIEWS AND ASSESSMENTS

If you are not applying for a scholarship, once the reference has been received the applicant will be invited to sit an online CAT4 assessment, this can be taken from home or at their current school and is invigilated by the admissions office.

If English is not the students first language, they will be invited to sit an additional test, which is an online PASSWORD assessment. The applicant will be invited for an online Interview with a senior member of the admissions team or a housemaster/mistress.
