The meeting was called to order at 2:35 p.m. by M. Wayman. Mrs. Wayman asked everyone to review the minutes from our January meeting and let us know if there were any changes needing to be made. Hearing none, the minutes were approved.

### New Business:

#### Title One Update - M. Wayman

- April 8, 2025 we will have a Title 1 audit
- They review 6 years of Title 1 information that we have kept.
- Next year's Title 1 status is still unknown.
- If targeted - Title 1 funds can only be used on identified students.
  - We have to submit a rubric to use in identifying students
  - Still working the rubric
- Title 1 funding for next year is based on this year's 135th day enrollment.

#### Ci3T update - M. Wayman & H. Morris

- Mrs. Wayman
  - shared that Ci3T is a format we go through to think about the different areas of the school.
  - Ci3T is bigger than just PBIS.

- RVES has a Ci3T team that meets monthly. Mrs. Morris is one of the team members and is here to share about Ci3T.
- Mrs. Morris
  - Mrs. Morris began by sharing where we were
  - **Before Ci3T:**
    - Each teacher/grade level had their own behavior system (clip chart, red, green, yellow cards, etc.)
    - Had a more reactive approach to behaviors
    - Rewards were tangible - treats, toys, etc.
  - **After Ci3T**
    - School-wide behavior system
    - Proactive approach to behaviors (Precorrection)
      - **Precorrection** - we teach or remind them of the expected behavior before an activity, lesson, etc.
        - Ex. How can we be responsible?
        - Show me one way to be responsible?
    - Rewards are meaningful experiences
      - Students turn in stickers for meaningful experiences such as
        - Security check with Officer Jagger
        - Making Friendship Bracelets
        - Kickball
        - Admin for 20 minutes
    - Committee surveyed 3 people to get data on if we know the expectations; when they gave out the last sticker etc.
    - Asking 4th/5th grade students about what rewards they would like to see us use.

### Safety Update - Mr. Lewis

- We have different safety drills we practice throughout the year.
  - Monthly Fire Drills - working on systems to be sure we identify everyone is out safely.
  - Earthquake Drill
  - Severe Weather Drill
  - Lockdown Drill - 1 per semester
- Other information:
  - District has monthly safety meetings that Mr. Lewis attends
    - Give us any changes/updates to Safety Drills
  - District has Summer Safety Sessions

- School Safety Survey - sent out to staff. The district uses the information to meet each school's safety needs.
- Safety Advisory Committee -
  - work with Ci3T to help students feel safe at school
  - If any injuries at school - what can we do different
  - Any area of concern - try to figure a solution
- N. Zorn asked about where students go for Tornado Drills?
  - Classroom downstairs - students go in class bathroom
  - Classrooms upstairs - come down to the lower floor hallways

### **School Improvement Plan - M. Wayman**

- 5 year increment - so our current SIP started in 2022.
- Each year we can change or modify our goal if necessary.
- Purpose - to be transparent and plan for the future.
- Next meeting will share our goals, how we did, and make adjustments to plan

### **School Report Card - M. Wayman**

- Parent/Student/Teacher Survey is part of the data collected for our School Report Card
- M. Wayman wanted feedback from the committee on how we can make the questions easier to understand
- Should we put questions in the newsletter and ask parents their understanding of the question.
- M. Wayman shared the types of Parent Survey Questions with the committee.
  - Learning Environment
  - Home/School Relations
  - Parent Communication
  - Student Safety

  - H. Morris suggested putting 1 question per week in the newsletter.
