7.1 LCAP Survey (Cassie Gosset to present)

Cassie provided an overview of the **Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)**, including funding priorities and support for English Learners, foster youth, and low-income students. She shared the presentation link and a QR code for survey participation.

Key Discussion Points:

• **Parent Concerns:** Limited instructional time for foster students, lack of communication with aides, and transition challenges for students changing schools.

• **Equity Issues:** Reduced field trips for Special Day classes, fewer volunteer opportunities, and a need for better support for non-college career pathways (e.g., EMT, nursing).

• **Communication Gaps:** Need for improved outreach on parent involvement and clearer pathways to volunteer.

• **School Transitions:** Requests for better support when Special Education students are moved between schools; parents suggested student tours and transition IEP meetings.

• **Middle School Placement:** Specific concern raised about Hogan Middle School being the only option in the area.

• **Parent Engagement:** Mixed feedback on meeting formats—some prefer virtual, others support hybrid or in-person formats.
