## Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) is for your child AND for you!

Early Childhood Family Education is based on the idea that the family provides a child's first and most significant learning environment and parents are a child's first and most important teachers.

- ECFE offers classes for parents and their children ages birth to 5 years old (*before Kindergarten*).
- Programs are designed for parents and their infants, toddlers and preschool-aged children.
- Classes help strengthen family relationships and provide information and resources to parents in their journey to help their children grow and develop to their maximum potential.
- Programs strive to build a strong foundation for families by forming a partnership between home and school.

### A typical ECFE class includes three components:

**1**

#### **Parent-Child Time**

You and your child spend time together enjoying activities designed to enhance their learning.

**2**

#### **Parent Time**

Meet with other parents and a licensed parent educator to discuss topics such as development, temperament, discipline and getting ready for school. The parent time takes place in a separate room or in a designated area of the children's classroom for non-separating classes.

**3**

#### **Children's Classroom**

While you and other parents participate in parent time, children learn through play in the classroom with a licensed early childhood teacher and a paraprofessional. Children will enjoy music, art, stories, large and small motor activities as they interact with other children.

## Selecting a Class

Choose a class based on your child's age as of September 1, 2025.

This date is used to determine eligibility for classes for both Semester I and Semester II.

## Determine Fees

Use the sliding fee scale chart to determine the fee for the first child attending the class. Any additional children attending the same class are half the fee. Include total class fee for all children attending class in total tuition due.

## Additional Children

Any additional children ages 0–4 must be registered for the class. If they don't meet the required age for the class, they can not attend.

## Non-School Days for Older Children

Any child who is not registered for the ECCE class, including Pop in and Play, cannot attend the class for any reason. On non-school days for older children, please make other arrangements for that child.

## Payments

Payment for Semester I and II are due at the time of registration.

## Class Confirmations

Please include your email and phone number when registering to receive an important class confirmation. If class is full, you'll be added to the waitlist and notified by phone if a spot opens.

## Immunization Records

Immunization records MUST accompany your registration. Class registrations will not be processed without an up-to-date immunization record each school year. Immunization records can be faxed directly from your clinic to 651-748-7271, Attn: ECCE.

## Cancellations and Refunds

We reserve the right to cancel classes if registration does not meet minimum requirements by September 9 for Semester I and January 16 for Semester II. Classes canceled due to insufficient enrollment will be refunded.

Participants who choose to cancel their registration will be subject to a \$10 fee and a pro-rated refund.

- Before week 1: 100% refund minus a \$10 cancellation fee
- If week 1 of class has occurred: 75% refund and \$10 fee
- If week 2 of class has occurred: 50% refund and \$10 fee
- If week 3 of class has occurred: 25% refund and \$10 fee
- If week 4 of class has occurred: no refund

Classes missed by participants and cancellations due to weather conditions are not refundable and will not be made up.

### What happens during Screening?

- We check vision and hearing
- Review immunization record and health history

### What happens after Screening?

- You will learn about your child's results
- You can find out about community resources and Early Childhood Programs


