- The heater fan motors in the EMS art room were replaced last month and they are working properly.
- We are complete with the yearly mower PM.

- We had 6 blower motors at at Carberry for a few months. We were able to place space heaters in these rooms until we receive the
 replacement parts that we needed. The supplier that I order these motors from have become very slow in their response time. I have
 found another supplier in hopes that their response time on orders is faster. This is something that I have been worried about for
 some time now, that the units are becoming outdated. We currently have around 90 of these units around the district. Most of them
 are in Shadow Butte or Carberry.
- Todd has started with my department and is currently working on clean up of leaves, fence lines, and gutters around the district.
- I have ordered the first round of irrigation supplies to get us started for the year.
- I was approved to order the equipment needed to maintain the turf on the football field. We have received this equipment and will put them to use after Michael Pennington from Shaw Sports Turf trains us on the proper techniques for the field.
- We were able to use our new UTV's this year for snow removal and they were very helpful.
- West Tech boiler works were out last month for some issue that we were having with one of the boilers at Carberry. We needed to replace the main blower unit for the boiler.
- Total System Services were out last week to look over the cooling towers and start them up for the cooling season. These units are at Carberry and Shadow Butte.
- We have the water turned back on in our outdoor restrooms and EHS and EMS.
- We have applied our first round of fertilizer to the grounds.
- We changed the HVAC filters in all of the schools over spring break.
- We have turn on the irrigation system to EMS, Butte View, and Shadow Butte. When the irrigation water is at the correct level int he
 ditches we will start the other systems. The water is usually starts to fill the ditches around April 15th.
