Display.

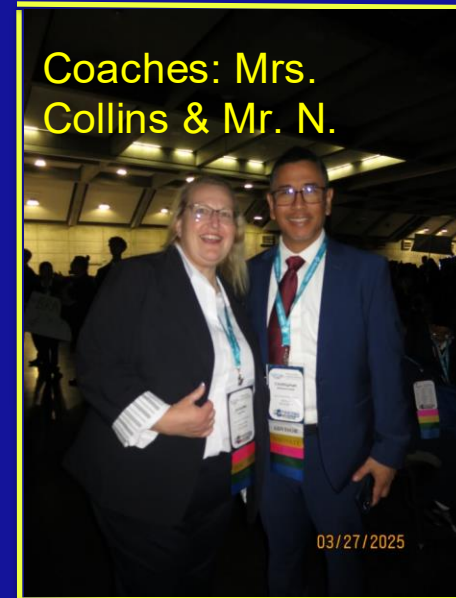

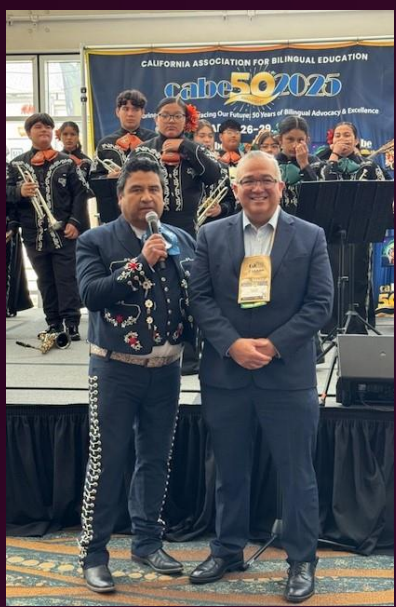
CABE Project 2 Inspire
