- No moshing or potentially harmful dancing and everyone must be standing upright at all times (no bending, hands on floor, squatting down to the floor, etc.)
- No intimate contact that is inappropriate such as grinding, etc.
- The dress code must be maintained throughout the dance.
- No foul language or gestures.
- No crowding in the center.
- All students need to remain in supervised areas and be seen by the chaperones.
- All students and guests must be picked up/leave campus within 30 minutes after the dance ends.

Dance Rules:

- Students must present a valid ID and their signed dance guidelines to enter the dance.
- Students will not be allowed to re-enter the dance upon leaving.
- Students under the influence or in possession of alcohol or other drugs will be reported to law enforcement and subject to school disciplinary guidelines.
- All school rules apply.
