

## Consequences for Violation of Code of Conduct

Violation of the Code of Conduct may result in a student being suspended from activities. Attendance, citizenship, and academics can have short-term consequences or upon the discretion of the athletic director, follow the Infraction steps listed below. Any infractions involving drugs, alcohol, and tobacco automatically following the steps listed below:

1. For a first infraction of the Code of Conduct policy in a student athlete's high school career, the student will be suspended for twenty-one (21) calendar days from participation in interscholastic athletics beginning with the first OSAA playable date for that season. If the infraction takes place after the first contest of the season the suspension will begin with the date the student has been notified by an administrator.
  - a. By agreement between the coach, staff and athletic director, the student-athlete may attend all practice sessions.
  - a. Reinstatement of the student-athlete to the athletic program is contingent upon the athletic director's approval for reinstatement in the program.
  - b. Failure to comply with the recommendations following a first offense will result in the removal of the athlete from the athletic program until he/she receives the athletic director's approval for reinstatement.
  
2. For the second infraction of the Code of Conduct policy in a student-athlete's high school career, the student will be suspended for forty-two (42) calendar days from participation in interscholastic athletic competition beginning with the first OSAA playable date for that season. If the infraction takes place after the first contest of the season the suspension will begin with the date the student has been notified by an administrator.
  - b. By agreement between the coach, staff and athletic director, the student-athlete may attend all practice sessions.
  - c. Reinstatement of the student athlete to the athletic program is contingent upon the athletic director's approval for reinstatement in the program.
  - d. Failure to comply with the recommendations following a second offense will result in the removal of the athlete from the athletic program until he/she receives the athletic director's approval for reinstatement.
  
3. For the third infraction of the Code of Conduct policy, the student will be suspended from participation in all athletic events for the duration of his/her high school career.
