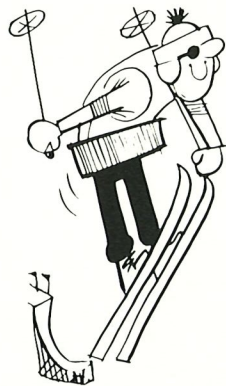
Organizations

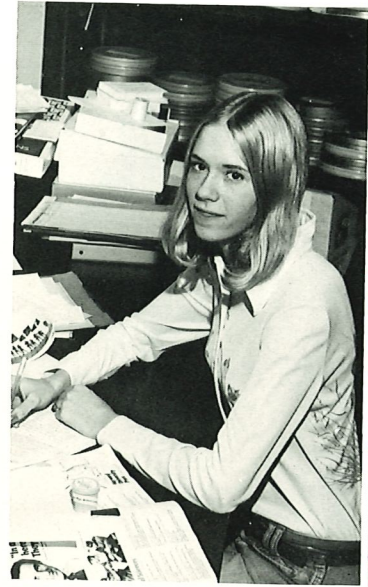
The clubs all have many members who enjoy the fun and work involved to make new friends and learn more about people in and out of the school.

Eileen: Letters and jackets were presented to seniors and underclassmen at the annual All Honors Banquet held at the Taylor Hose Company.

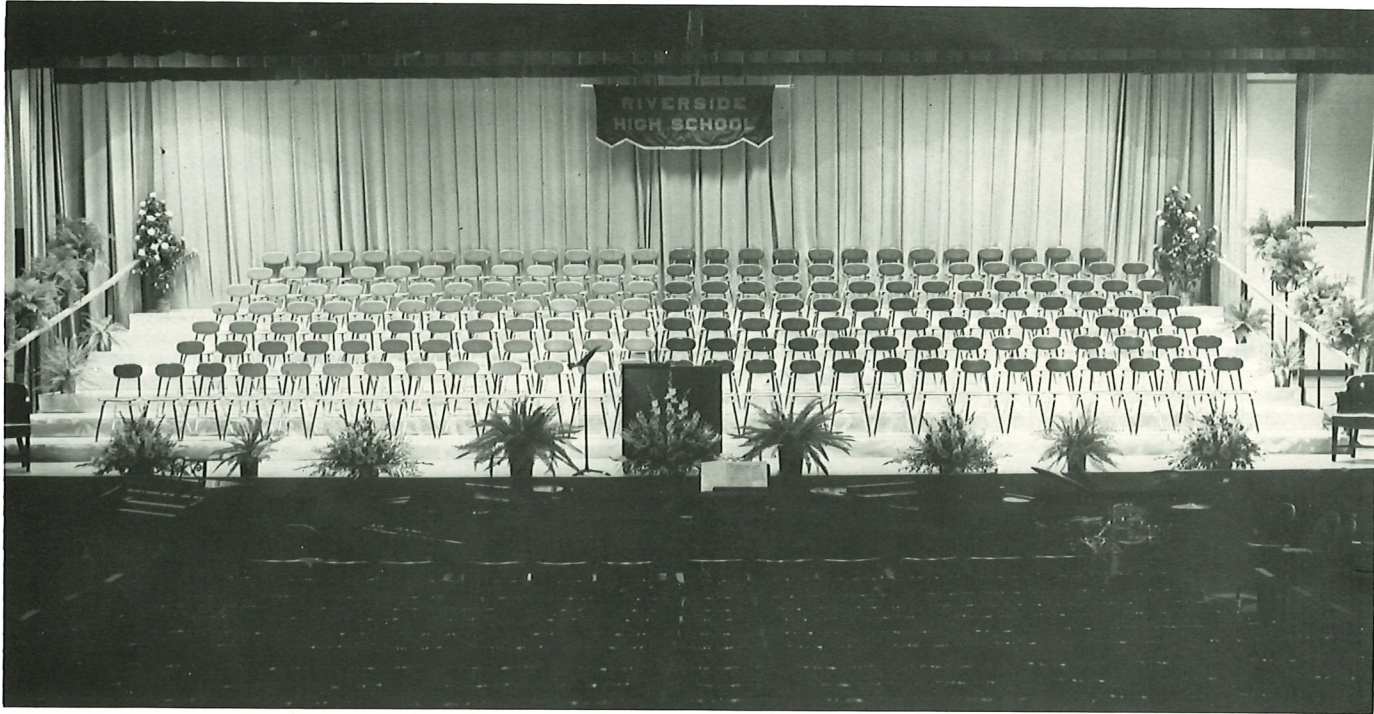

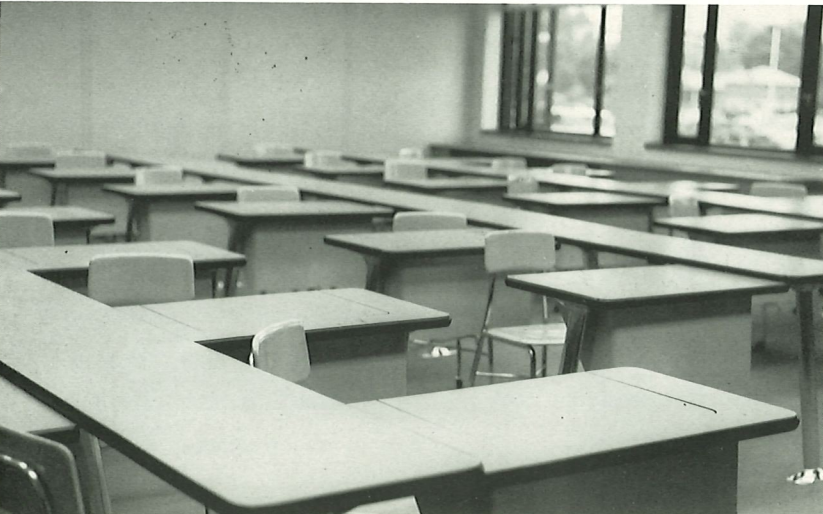
Eileen: The year ended with Class Day and Class Night, but most of all, our memorable graduation night.

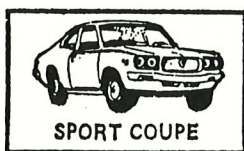

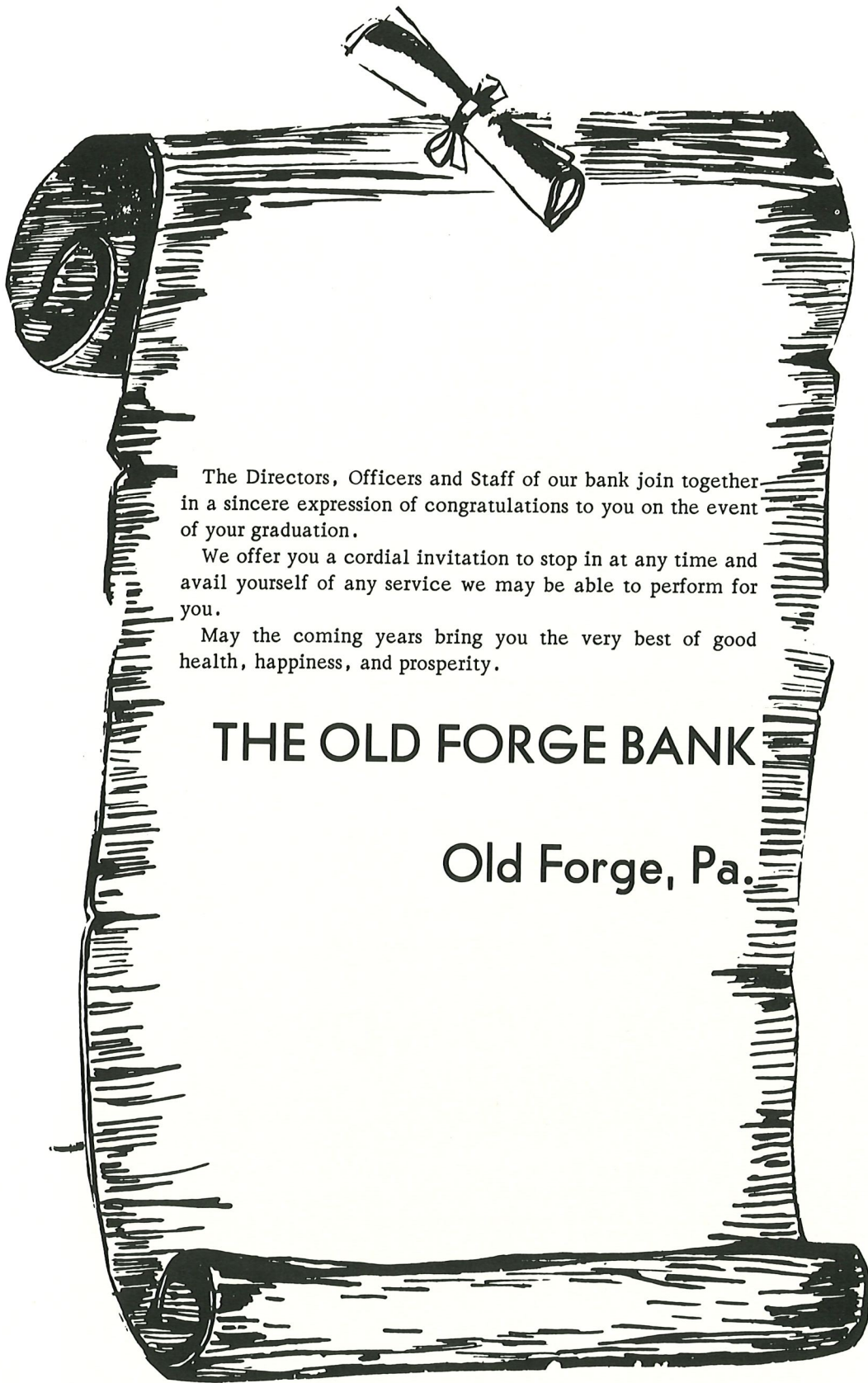
