

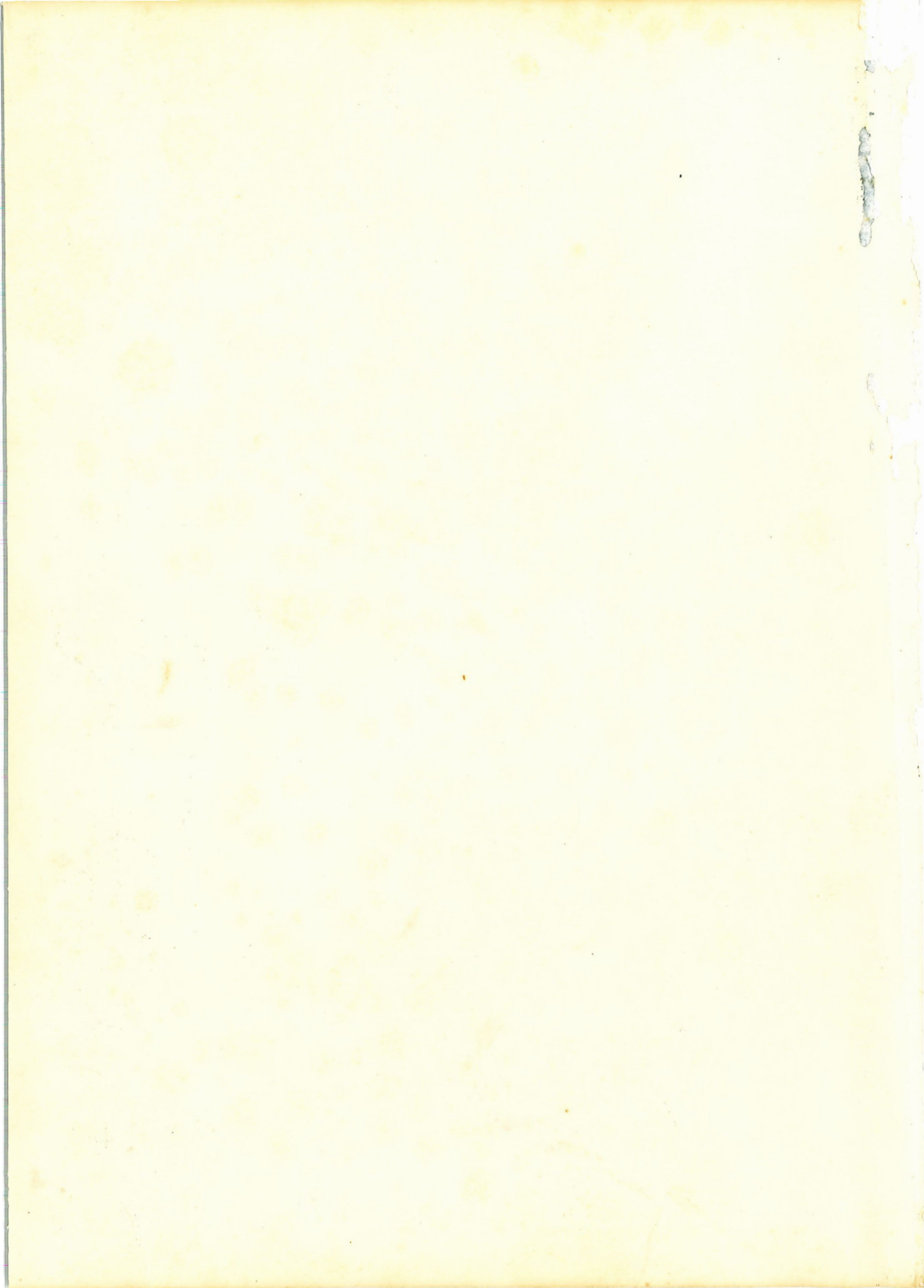

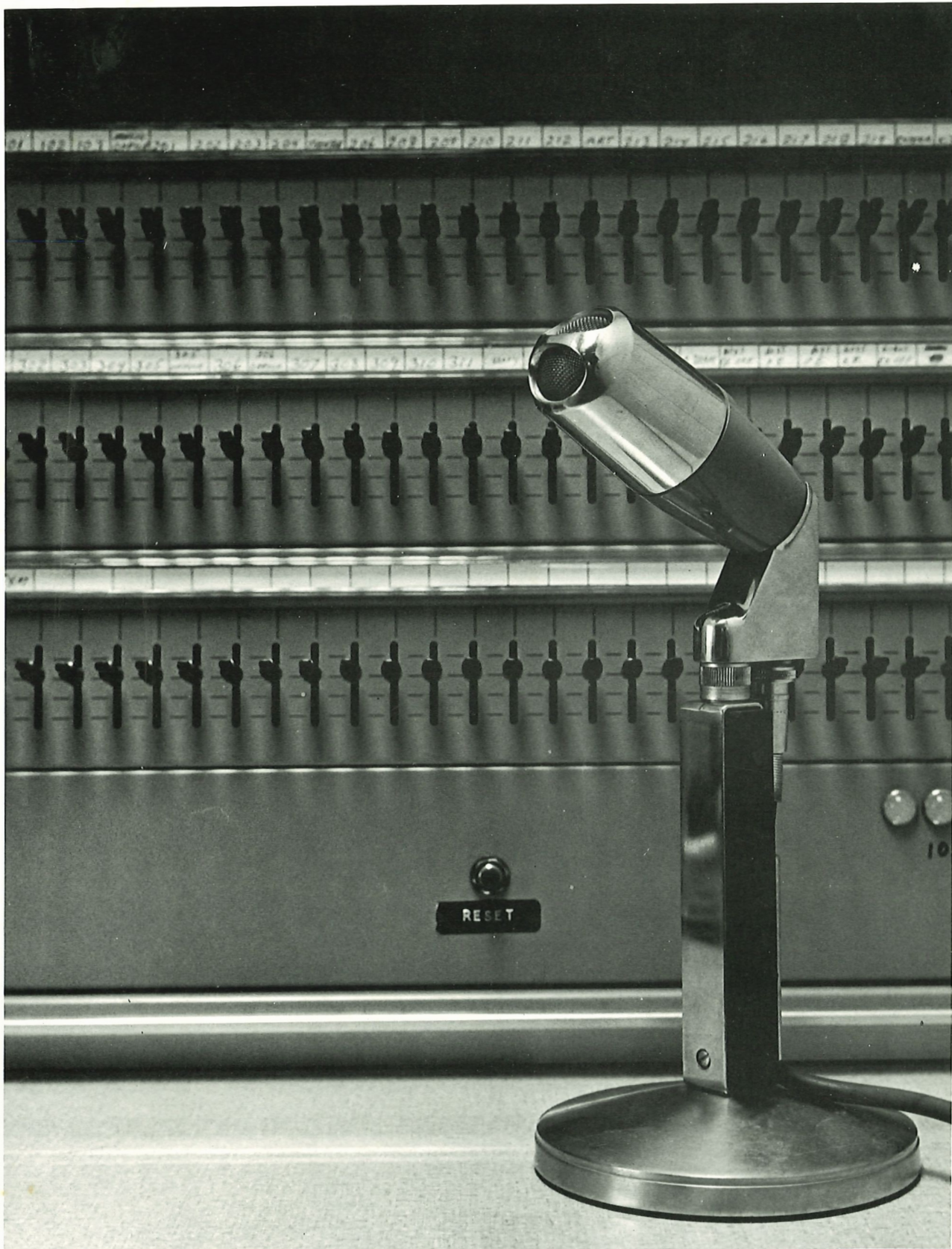

Or am I going to be prepared to move calmly in full possession of my faculties to assess a situation in order to determine what has to be done to produce changes that will strengthen not weaken the total societal structure - moral, social, economic, political. Let us settle on one thing - that change must come - it is inevitable. But let us agree that it must come through a rational peaceful approach not by intimidation and violence.

Since democracy provides for greater individual freedom than any other government on the face of the earth, it is wisdom or folly to use the democratic processes to bring about the demise of that form of government which guarantees those liberties?

There is little that can be said against an honest commitment for change within the limits of the American Bill of Rights and according to principles set forth in the Constitution.

Above all it is imperative that we preserve our dignity and self-respect and maintain a posture of self-control.
