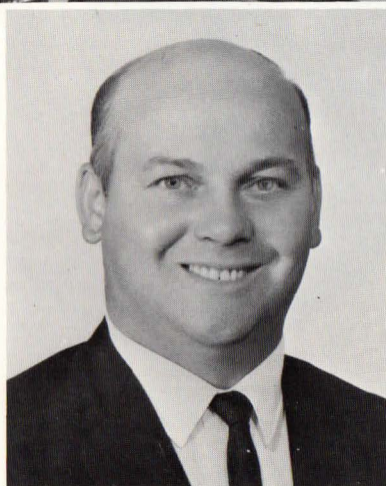

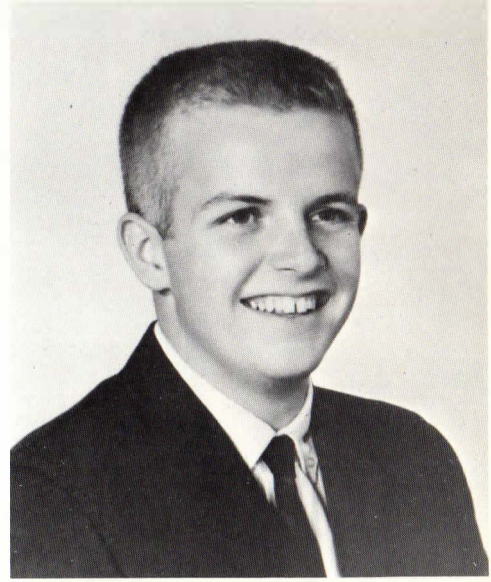

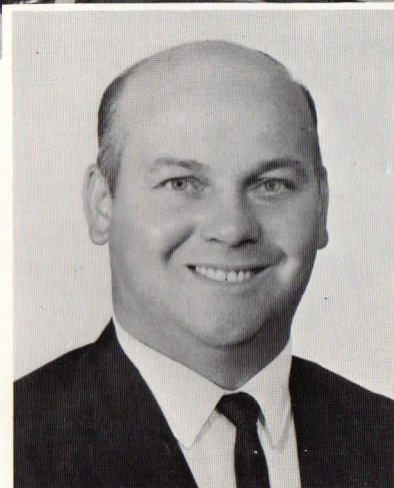
The '66 VIKING was planned when the school year began. While you, the student body, studied and played the year away, staff members were busy assembling your yearbook.

Combo Springs From Spring Festival

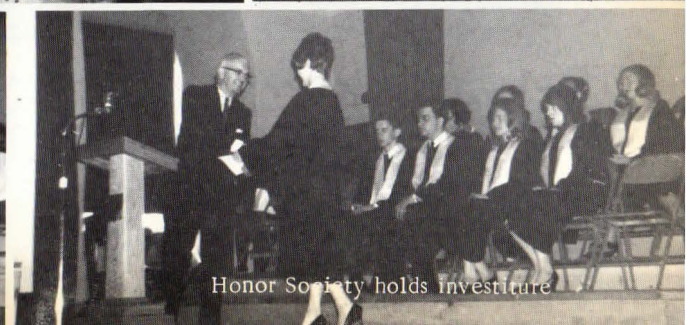
