

MIDDLE SCHOOL VIRTUAL LEARNING EXPECTATIONS

Please review the following expectations for the middle school students. In order to provide the best virtual learning experience possible for all our students, we need your help in ensuring they consistently comply with the guidelines below. Thank you for your cooperation and support!



- Students are required to have a working camera and microphone. If a family does not have either of these, families need to contact the school to get a camera or microphone within 24 hours of the device not working. Please contact admin@moonachieschool.org.
- Students should be in front of the camera with an unblurred view.
- Students should not be watching television or playing video games during class.
- Students should have a set school learning environment within the home. Ideally, Students should not be laying in bed while in class.
- Students should be able to show work on camera and share it via Google Classroom.
- Students should respond audibly when addressed or called upon (unless asked to be excused and given permission by the teacher).
- Students need to be aware how to turn in work on Google Classroom.
- Chat should be reserved for in class conversations... not personal discussions.
- Attendance is mandatory for ALL classes (including Specials). If a student needs to leave due to a doctor's appointment, then a parent needs to contact the front office.
- Students should not leave Google Classroom (attendance) to go to the bathroom, eat, etc. without permission of the teacher.
