Moonachie Families & Friends:

The Robert L. Craig School takes each positive case of COVID-19 with the upmost concern. With COVID-19 positive cases steadily increasing in New Jersey, in Bergen County, and in the Borough of Moonachie, data points are changing from what we experienced in August and September. As a result, we have been analyzing the data and making adjustments to our programming as we learn more about the virus, its spread, and with updated guidance from local health officials. Today's pandemic climate is much different than that of the Summer and September. We must adjust our approach accordingly.

The Bergen County Department of Health are the local officials who provide recommendations on quarantining and closure. With each recommendation, it is clear that they are committed to preventing the spread of each positive COVID-19 test through closures and quarantines. We must report to the Bergen County Department of Health all contacts of a positive case (any person in the same room as the positive test, regardless of proximity) for the 48-hours prior to the onset of symptoms.

All cases identified by Nurse Gallo and myself have been contact traced to *weekend* exposure. All cases experienced symptoms on Tuesday evening or Wednesday morning, thus excluding them from school on Wednesday. Based on what we know about this virus, each individual would have been asymptomatic on Monday and Tuesday, while the virus incubated. So far, our policies and procedures to reduce the possibility of spread within the building have proven successful. Social distancing, masks, windows, sanitation, not mixing of cohorts, etc... have prevented any other individual in our building from contracting COVID-19 during these asymptomatic days.

With the holiday's approaching and indoor activities increasing, we have devised a plan for November and December to help lower the risk of weekend community spread impacting the Robert L. Craig School.

Our hope with this plan is to identify possible COVID-19 cases following the asymptomatic period, of 2-4 days. This lowers possible exposure of the virus to our school community. But like any plan with this virus, it is not fool-proof. But we feel it is our next logical step forward in response to our data points.

Starting November 16th, we will move into Mondays and Tuesdays being FULL REMOTE Learning for All Students. We will follow our FULL-Day schedule: 8:55am-3:05pm.

Wednesday, Thursday, and Fridays we will be open for full-day LIVE instruction, with all health and safety protocols unchanged. Our plan for Recess and Lunch will remain unchanged.

MYMEDBOT will remain ACTIVE on Mondays and Tuesdays. We ask that all LIVE families continue to fill out MYMEDBOT on Remote Days. This will allow us continue to track symptoms and possible infections prior to re-opening on Wednesdays.
