Moonachie Families and Friends:

As always, Mrs. Genatt and I hope this message finds your family safe, healthy, and well. As we continue analyzing our health data, guided by the New Jersey Department of Health, and solidifying our processes and procedures, we could not be more proud of our students, staff, and families.

To date, we have had zero cases of COVID-19 within the Moonachie School District. Additionally, Bergen County remain in 'Green' as defined by the Department of Health. This identification indicates that transmission rates and positive cases for COVID-19 remain low. Based on these data points and recommendations from our local officials, it is the right time to plan for the next phases of our re-open.

Transition To Full Day Programming

We will begin to transition from one-session days to full-day programming. This process was carefully designed to ensure health and safety standards, as well as instructional equity for both Live and Remote learners. Each phase will be executed based upon current health data and communicated should timelines need to be altered.

Phase 1 Important Notes – October 13-October 30:

- Entrance times and procedures remain unchanged.
- Morning Bus Assignments, Pick Up Times, and Assigned Seats remain unchanged.
- Students in Grades K-2 who are registered for the bus, will be provided bussing at 3:05 via Bus 1.
- Students in Grades 3-8 who are registered for the bus, will be provided bussing at 1:00 via Bus 2.
- The PRE-K bus will provide service to those students registered for the bus at 3:05pm.
- Students in Grades 3-8 who attend the YMCA from 1pm-4pm will continue to do so, with no interruption to programming. This remains unchanged.
- Older Siblings, who walk home PK-2 students, would need to return to school at 3pm to pick-up their younger siblings.
- Families having students in different Phases, will be asked to schedule their pick-ups accordingly. However, please remember that the YMCA is available for grades 3-8 to help fill that 1pm-3pm gap of time, if your family needs that support. Please contact Mr. Facendola if you wish to explore this option.
- Grades PK-2 \rightarrow Lunch will be served in the classroom. We will continue to send home breakfast for the next day.
- Lunch and breakfast will remain Grab-and-Go for grades 3-8 during Phase 1.
- We will run two-separate dismissal times. The current CAR PICK UP lane process that we have been doing will be unchanged.

<u>Phase 2 Important Notes – Beginning November 2nd</u>

- Entrance times and procedures remain unchanged.
- We will return to our full school staggered dismissal times.
- 2:40-2:50pm → PK-2 Car Pick Up
- 2:50-3:00pm → Grades 3-5 Car Pick Up
- 3:00-3:05pm → Grades 6-8 Car Pick Up
- Students remain in their classrooms and teachers continue to travel.
- All social distancing, masks, bathroom rotations, hand sanitizing, etc... remain unchanged.

As we work through these next phases of our re-open and return to full day programming, our health officials and data points will guide us. If phases need to be delayed or we need to revert back a phase, it will be communicated as early as possible to provide families time to figure out their scheduling.
