Cell Phone & Personal Device Usage

As we roll out our 1-to-1 device initiative, we will discontinue the Bring Your Own Device Program. Students will no longer need to use cell phones or personal devices for instructional purposes. As a result, we ask that all student cell phones remain off during the school day. This removes the many distractions that personal cell phones come with and encourages more direct concentration on work and/or socializing directly with their peers. This includes during lunch & recess.

If you need to reach your child for any reason, our main office staff is more than happy to relay a message or get your child from class so you can speak with them. If a student is using his/her personal cell phone during class, he/she will receive one warning. If a second occasion occurs, the phone will be confiscated, the parent will be notified immediately, and the phone returned at dismissal. We Thank You for your partnership in this endeavor and are very excited for Moonachie to finally be a 1-to-1 district!

Start Strong State Assessment

We will be administering the Start Strong Assessment this fall for grades 4-8 in ELA, Math and Science. This test will have content from concepts and skills from the year before. For example, fourth grade students will be tested on third grade content. There will be one test for each content area. We will send out our testing schedule shortly.
