Teacher Assignments & Supply Lists

Morning Entrance

All students will enter through the Gymnasium doors this year (See Entrance Map attached on last page). The main entrance will not be used for students. Please pull as far down the 'horseshoe' as possible before stopping to let your student(s) out. Drop off is between 8:10am – 8:45am. Homeroom begins at 8:50am.

Dismissal

Dismissal will work very similar to last year. We will utilize the 'Car Line' to dismiss students individually. If weather permits, we are encouraging families to walk. This will decrease the number of cars in the line. We thank you in advance for your patience during our Dismissal process.

Dismissal will begin at 2:50pm for Grades PK-5. Grades 6-8 will dismiss at 3:05pm. If you have an older and younger student, please plan to pick both up at 3:05pm.

YMCA After School Program

YMCA After School Program for grades 3-8 will be fully operational this year. It is free of charge, from 3pm-6pm. Students will receive homework help, tutoring, enrichment opportunities, participate in STEM activities, and engage in physical activity.

We are excited to introduce the YMCA program this year for grades 1 & 2, from 3pm-6pm. This is a tuition-based program. Financial Assistance is available.

Bussing Assignments

We are finalizing our bussing assignments and bus stop times. Letters will be sent home next week. Remember: Masks must be worn on buses, seating will be assigned, and windows will be open.

Technology

Our 1-to-1 Technology initiative is underway! Every student will have an assigned device to use, while in school. We have received a majority of the devices. Our technology team is working to get all devices programmed. We are projecting for classroom teachers to be able to use the devices early this Fall.

School Store

We are excited to open our School Store, The Craig Shoppe, "on wheels" this year! The school store will visit classrooms a few times each month and students will earn ClassDojo points for Positive Behavior, which can be redeemed for prizes.

<u>Covid-19 Protocols – Very Similar to Last Year</u>

- 1) As per Executive Order 251:
 - a. All students and staff are required to wear face masks while indoors at school, unless: wearing a mask impedes an individual's health, when engaging in aerobic activities and able to maintain 6-feet of social distancing, when eating or drinking, or if listed as an accommodation in a student's IEP or Section 504 plan.
 - b. Masking is optional outside.
 - c. Masking is mandatory on all buses.
 - d. Increased mask breaks will occur during extreme heat for classrooms without Air Conditioning.

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- e. All visitors are required to wear a mask inside the building.
- 2) As per Executive Order 253:
 - a. All Employees of the Moonachie School District and the YMCA After School Program, as well as any individuals who perform regular duties at the school, will be fully vaccinated by October 18th OR will produce a Negative test for Covid-19, weekly.
- 3) As per NJDOE, there is No Remote Learning Option this year.
- 4) MyMedBot will be utilized. The questionnaire will mirror the current guidelines for exclusion. Ms. Spitaleri will be in touch with families next week if we are unable to activate your account from last year and/or if you are new to our district.
- 5) As per NJDOE guidelines, students will maintain a minimum distance of 3-feet. Per NJDOH, if students are between 3-6 feet apart in class and appropriately wearing their mask, quarantining will not be required.
- 6) Students will remain in cohorts. The exception is Physical Education. PE class will take place outside (weather permitting). Indoor PE class will maintain 6-feet of social distancing between students.
- 7) Cleaning and sanitizing will continue in our building throughout the day and each evening.
- 8) If a student is symptomatic during the school day, he/she will be isolated with Nurse Gallo in the isolation room. A parent/guardian will be called for immediate pick up from school.
- 9) If a student is symptomatic in the morning, the student will be marked absent. Nurse Gallo will advise the family based on current NJDOH guidelines. Students will be provided ample time to make up missed work upon their return to school. If your student is not feeling well, please keep them home.
- 10) Should a student, group of students, or entire classroom need to be quarantined, Synchronous Remote Learning will be activated for the duration of the Quarantine. As per NJDOE, quarantine is the only time Remote Learning will be utilized.
- 11) Should a student test positive for Covid-19, contact tracing will occur. Nurse Gallo will advise based on current NJDOH guidelines.
 - a. Close contacts will be contacted immediately and advised by Nurse Gallo.
- 12) Confirmed positive cases will be communicated to the entire school community.
- 13) NJDOH no longer recommends temperature screening. We will NOT be temperature screening.
- 14) All Visitors, including parents, will remain in the vestibule or outside. Only Staff and Students will be permitted past the front vestibule area.

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- 15) MERV-13 filters will continue to be utilized in our ventilation system and changed according to the manufacturers recommendations. Additionally, classroom windows will be open to introduce the freshair component.
- 16) Breakfast will be sent home for the following day.
