AGES BIRTH TO 5 (BEFORE KINDERGARTEN)

Early Childhood Information & Referral

ECFE Classes

ECFE Classes include Three Components:

Parent-Child Interaction

You and your child spend time together enjoying activities designed to enhance learning. You will leave with new ideas for things to do together at home.

Parent Education

Meet with other parents and a licensed ECFE teacher to discuss topics such as development, temperament, discipline, and getting ready for school. The parenting group time takes place in a separate room or in a designated area of the children's classroom for non-separating classes.

Children's Classroom

While parents participate in parent education, children learn through play in a classroom with early childhood staff. Children will enjoy music, art, stories, large and small motor activities as they interact with other children.





Infants

AGES BIRTH - 12 MONTHS

This class includes activities, songs, rhymes, movement, and parent discussion with a trained parent educator. You and your child will spend time together exploring toys and participating in classroom activities in a stimulating environment.

Playschool: A First Step into the Classroom

AGES 2-3 BY SEPT 1, 2025

Playschool offers children a supportive environment to build confidence in a classroom setting, practice following rules and routines, initiate social interactions, and develop a sense of belonging within a group.

In the fall, children attend with a parent or guardian in a traditional ECFE classroom, gradually building these skills. On Mondays, they begin separating during parent time. Starting November 18, 2025, a second child-only day will be introduced on Tuesdays. Children may attend this additional day once they turn 2.5 years old.

Cancellations

We reserve the right to cancel classes due to insufficient enrollment. Fees paid will be refunded. Refunds will not be issued for classes missed or after a class has started.

Determine Payment Due

Use the class fee schedule on the back cover to determine fee for the first child attending the class. Add half of the fee for each additional child from the same family attending the same class.

Payments

All one-time payments are due at the time of registration. Payments for full year classes will be split into three equal payments. The first payment will be due at the time of registration and the second and third payments will occur in November and February. No family will be denied participation due to inability to pay. If you need help with payments call 651-653-3100.

Refund Policy

Refunds will be issued when requested at least five working days prior to the class starting date. A \$10 service charge will be deducted from each refund processed.

Immunization Records

Immunization records MUST accompany the registration if your child is participating in an ECFE class. Class registrations will not be processed without an up-to-date immunization record each school year. Immunization records can be faxed directly from your clinic to 651-653-3155.

SCREEN AT THREE

Early Childhood Screening is required by the State of Minnesota for all children prior to entering kindergarten. White Bear Lake Area School District provides this screening at no charge.

- Screening can ensure school success
- ◆ If health or developmental concerns are identified, educational services are available immediately
- It is fun for children and provides caregivers with valuable information regarding child development
