Overview

Survey Design

- Survey questions organized into 3 categories:
 - Academics (5 questions)
 - Physical & Emotionally Safe Learning Environments (5 questions)
 - Parent & Community Engagement (7 questions)
- Opportunities for free responses
- Separate, but identical surveys for elementary, middle, and high
- Surveys requested school site, grade(s), ethnicity, and unduplicated identifiers but was otherwise anonymous
- Average completion time of 5-6 minutes per survey

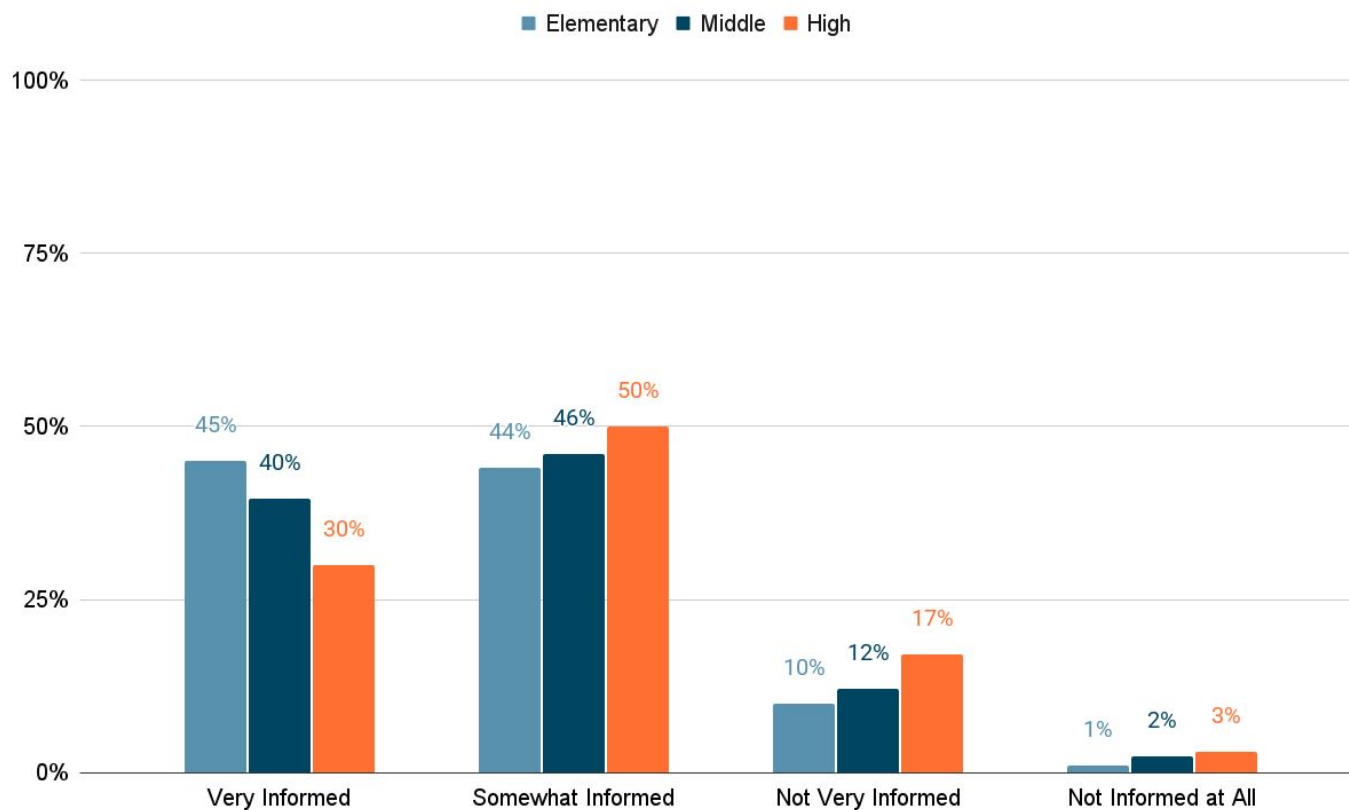
Participation

- Survey Period - January 21 to January 31, 2025
- 2,140 total responses + 10% from prior year
 - Elementary: 1,173
 - Middle: 471
 - High: 496
- 13% response rate from all parent/guardian contacts (17,000)
 - Some responses represent more than one student
 - Families may elect one parent/guardian to respond

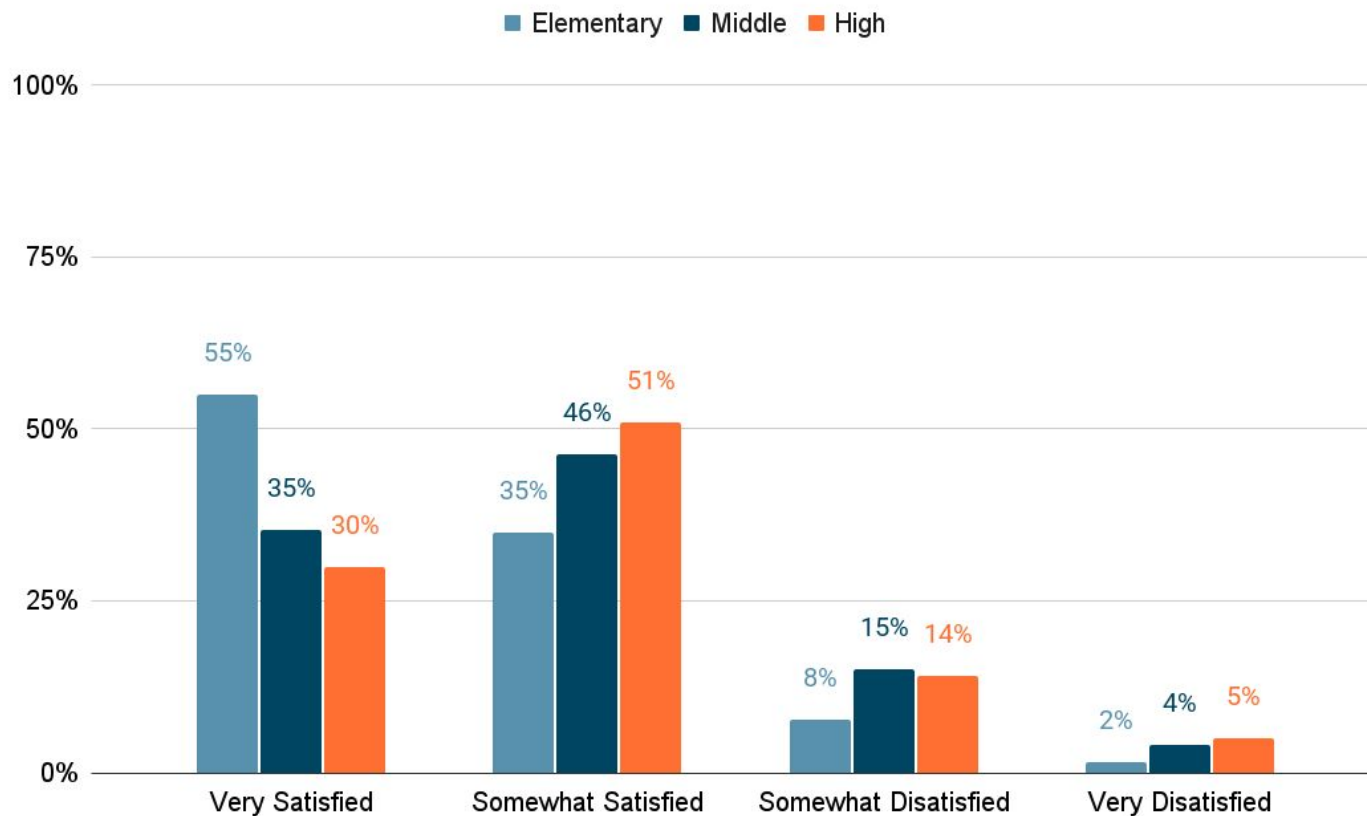

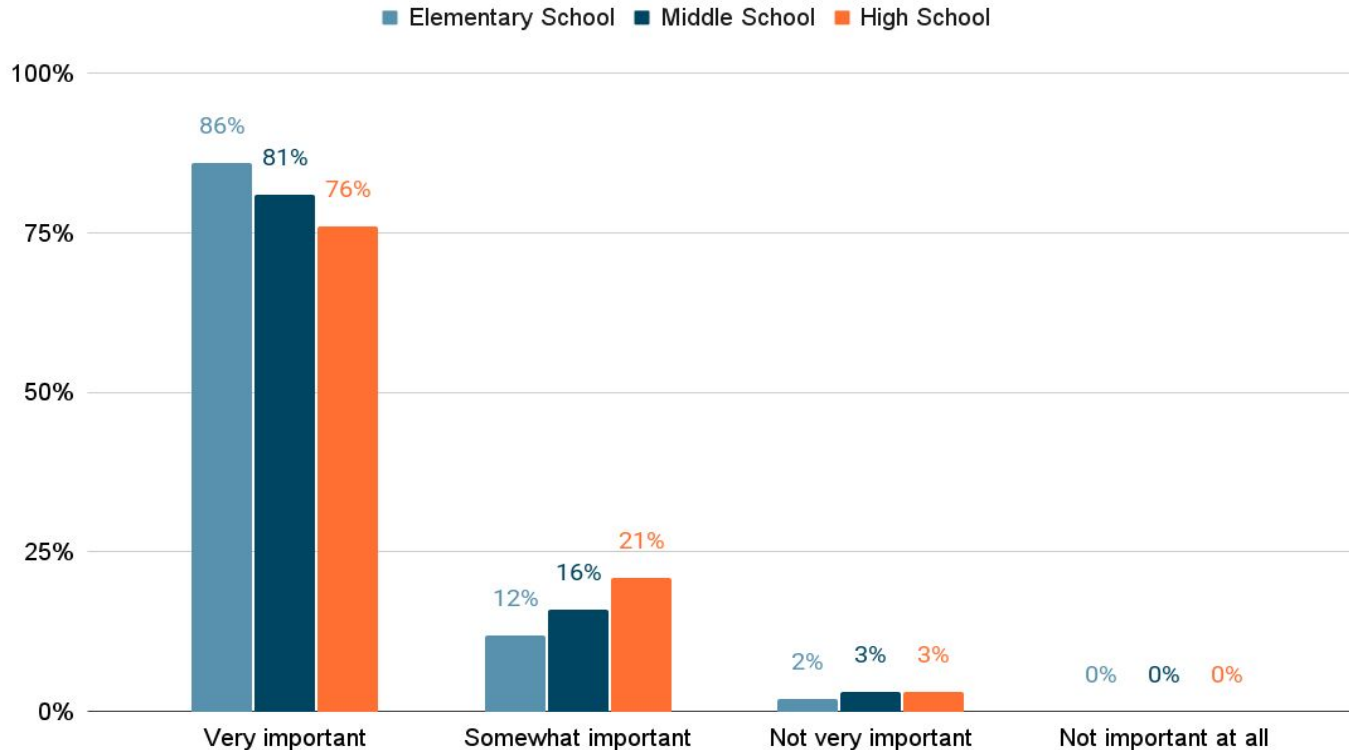

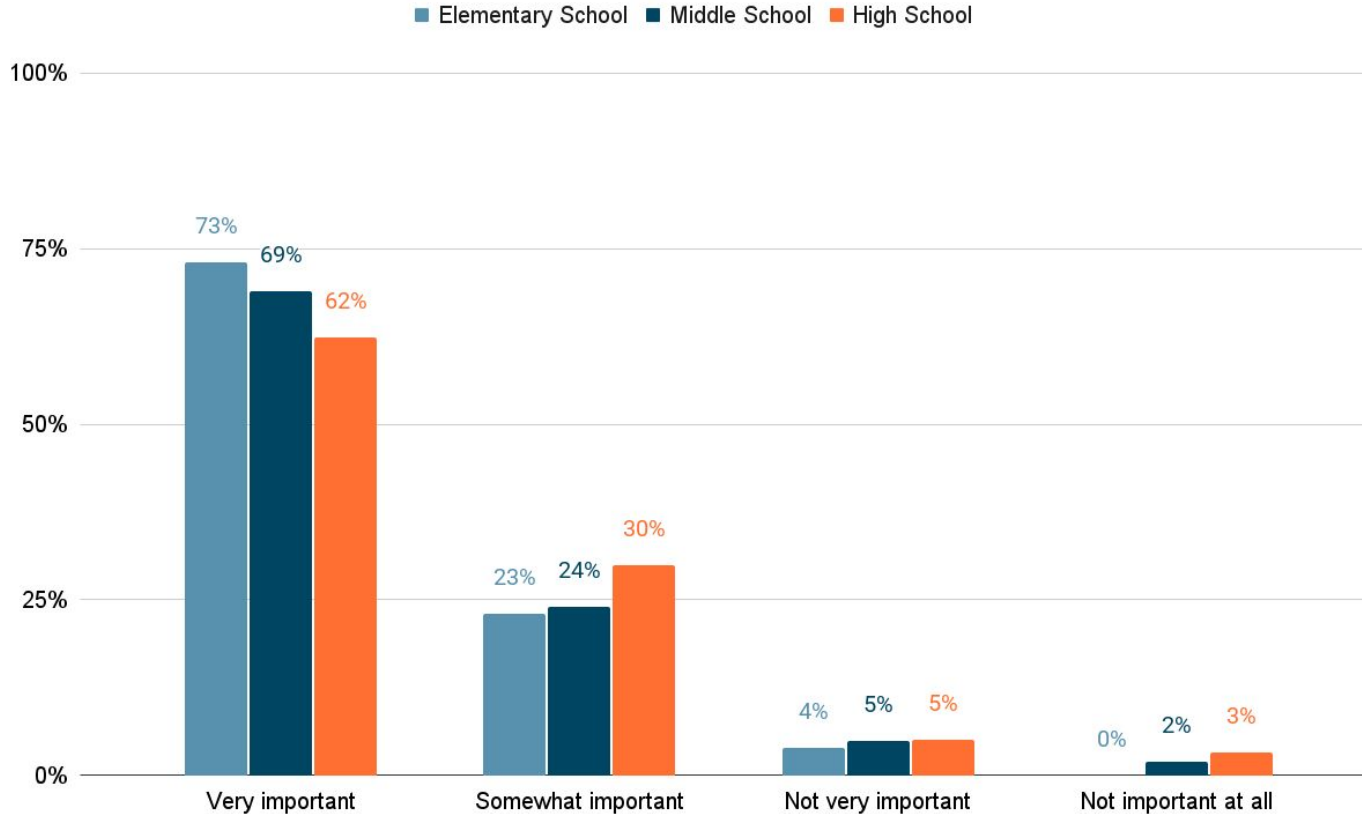

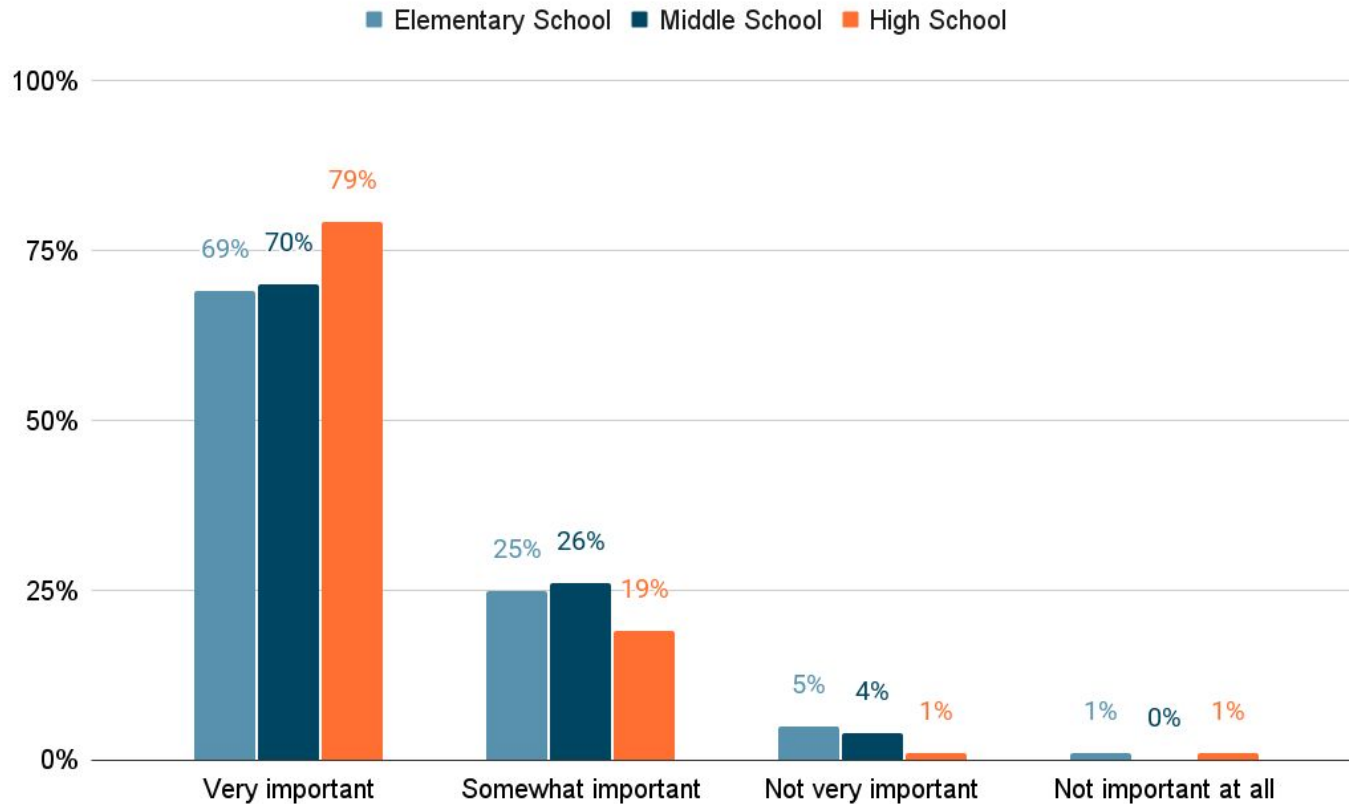

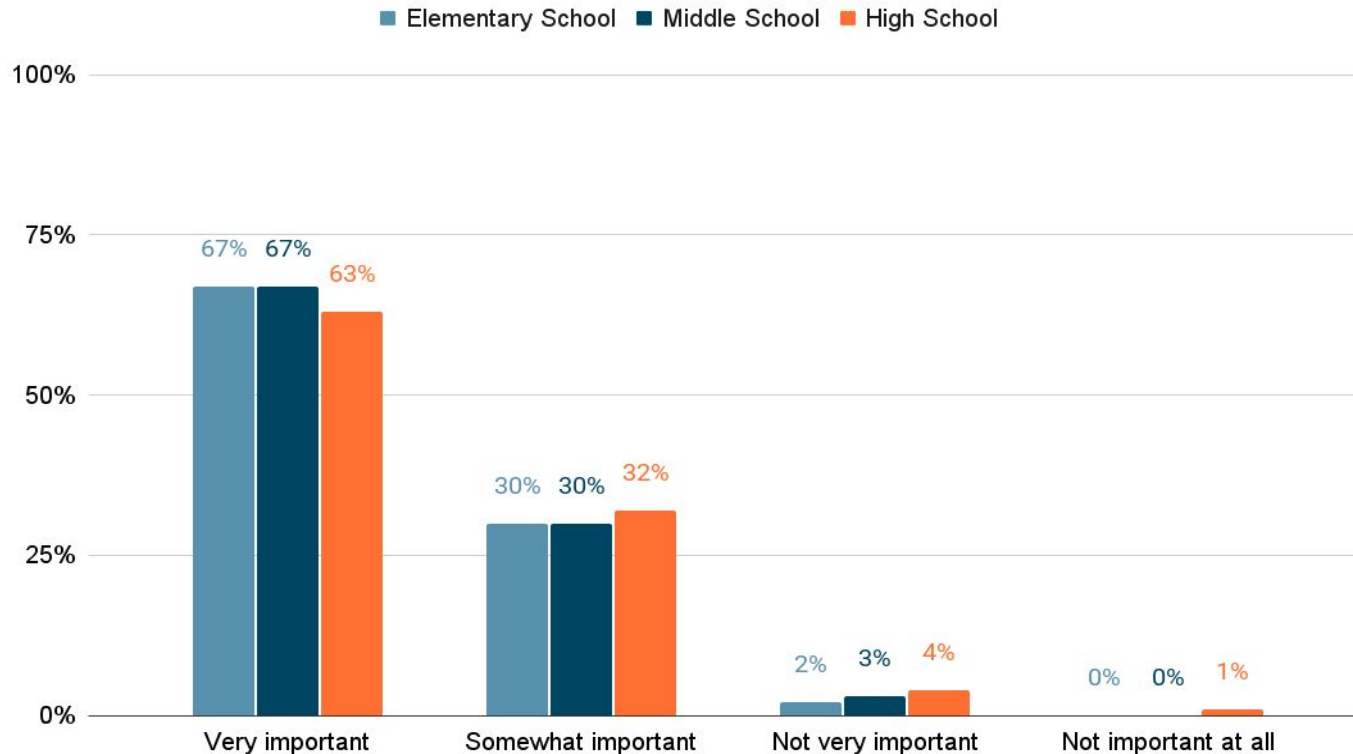

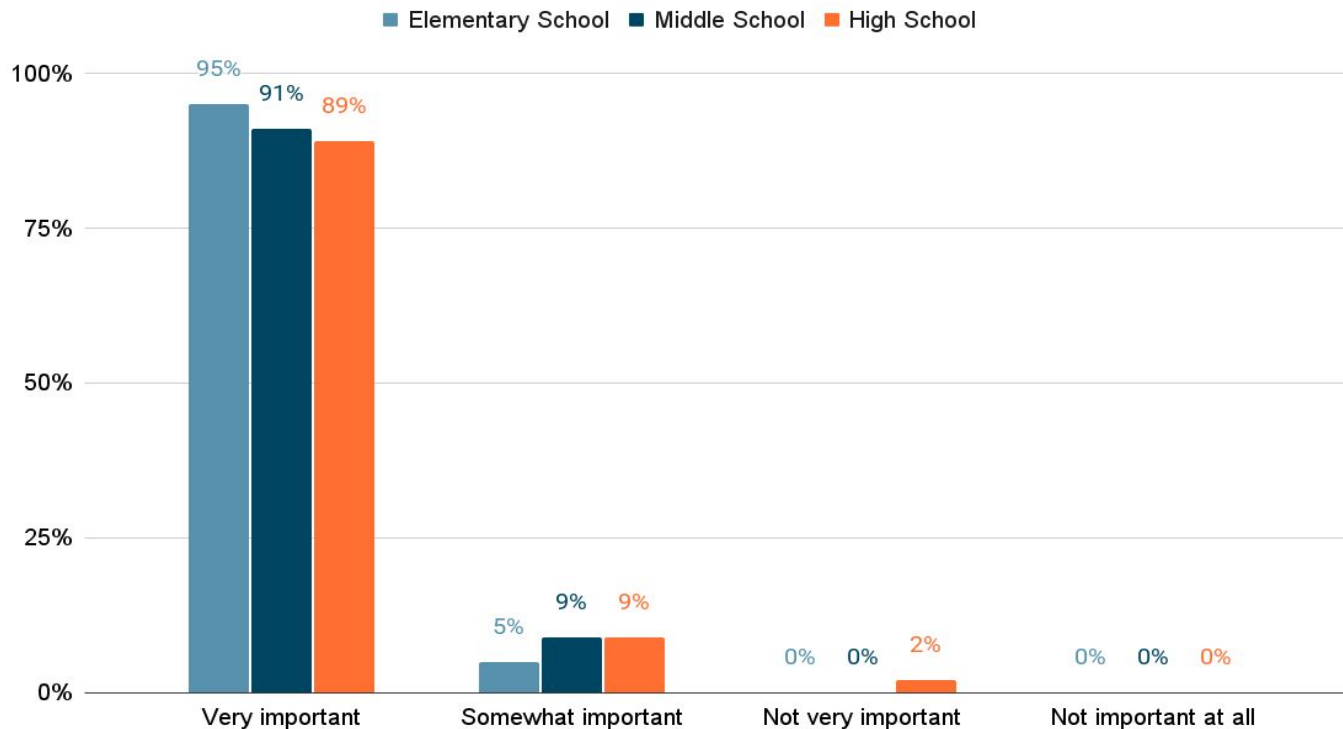

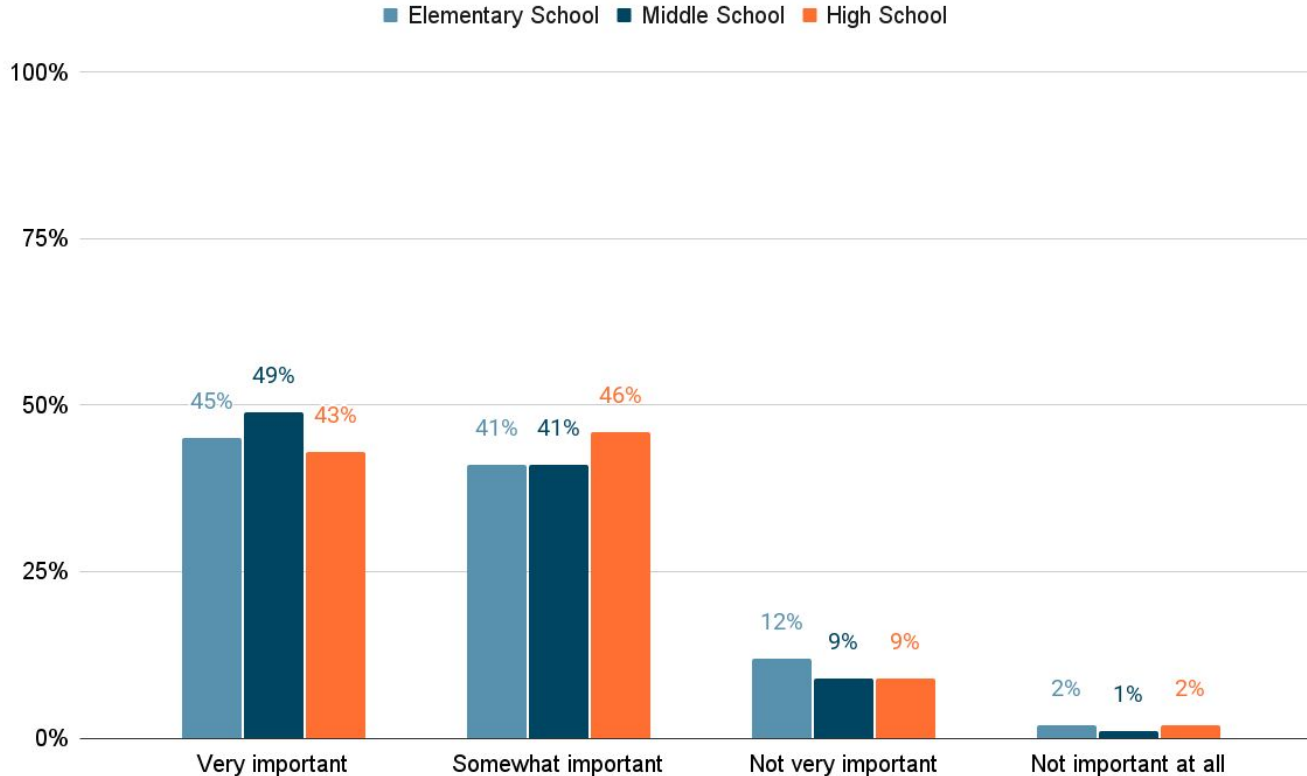

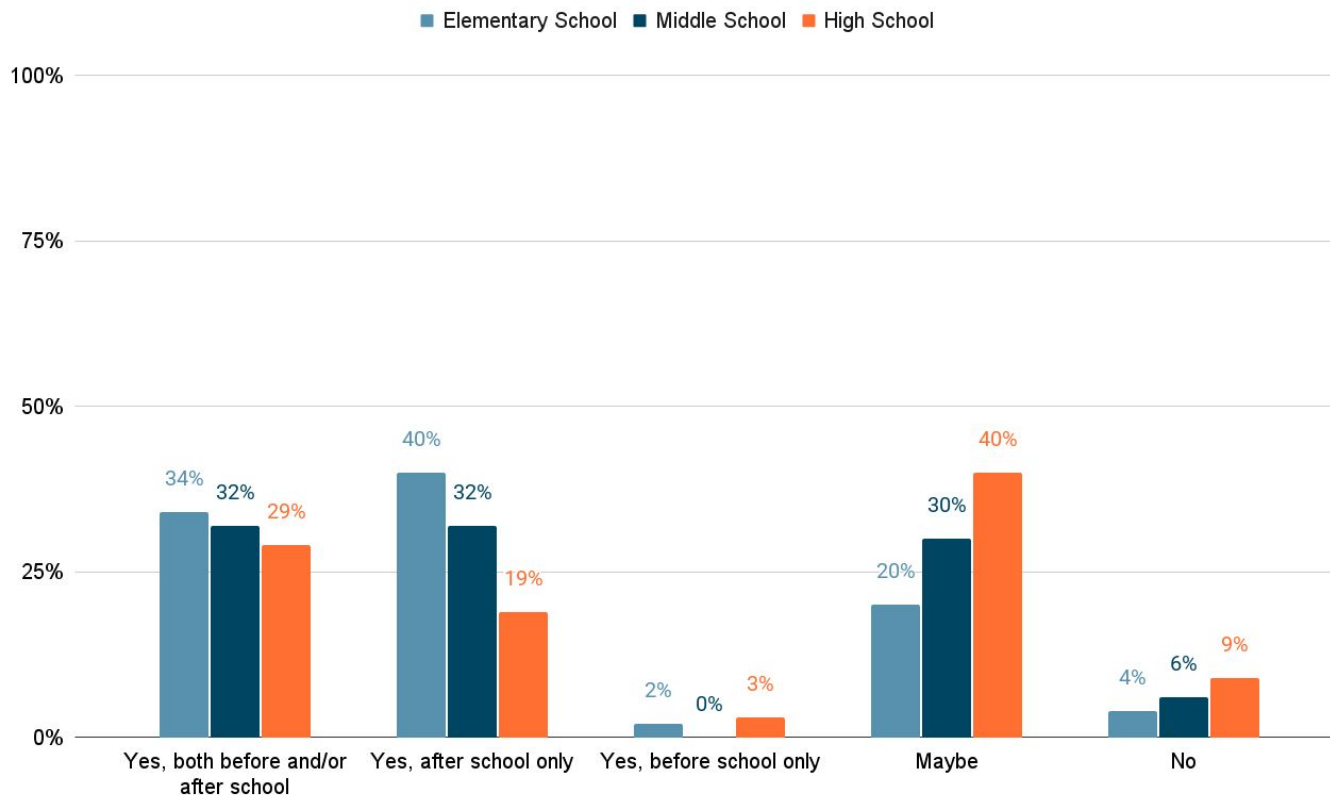

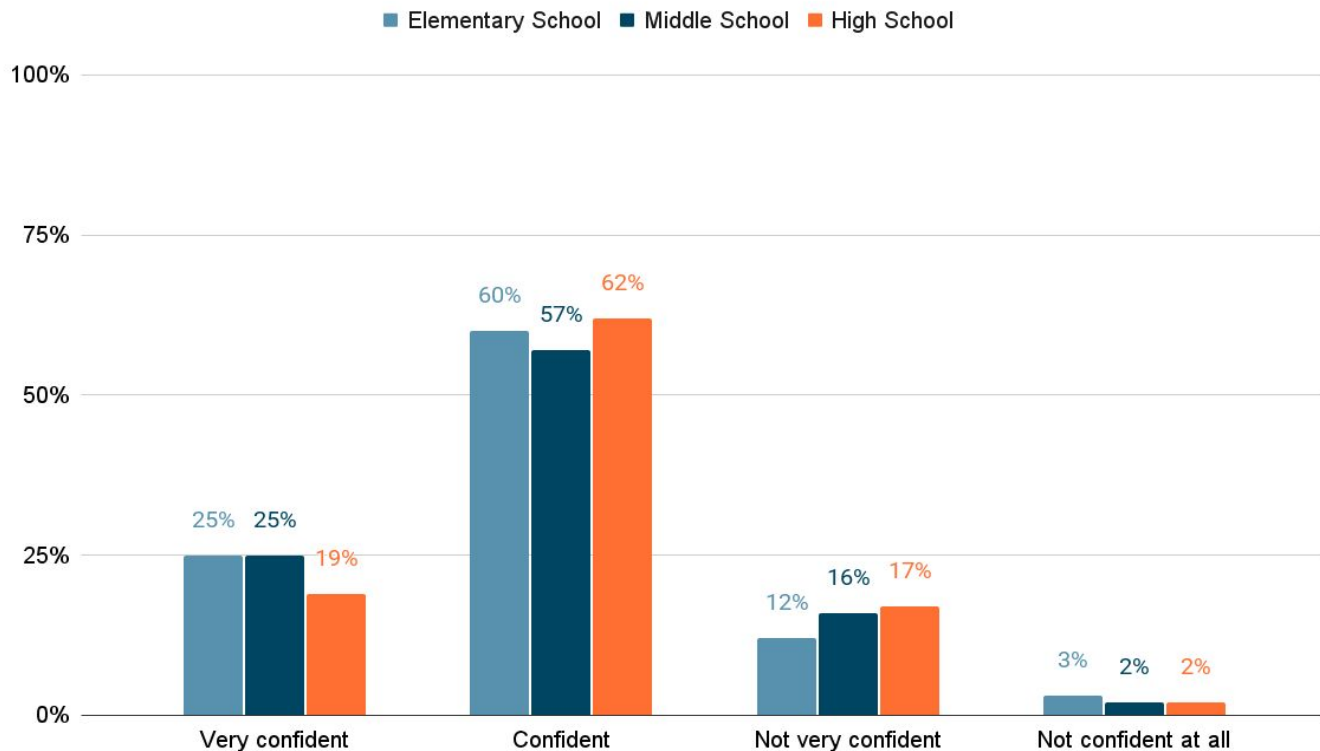

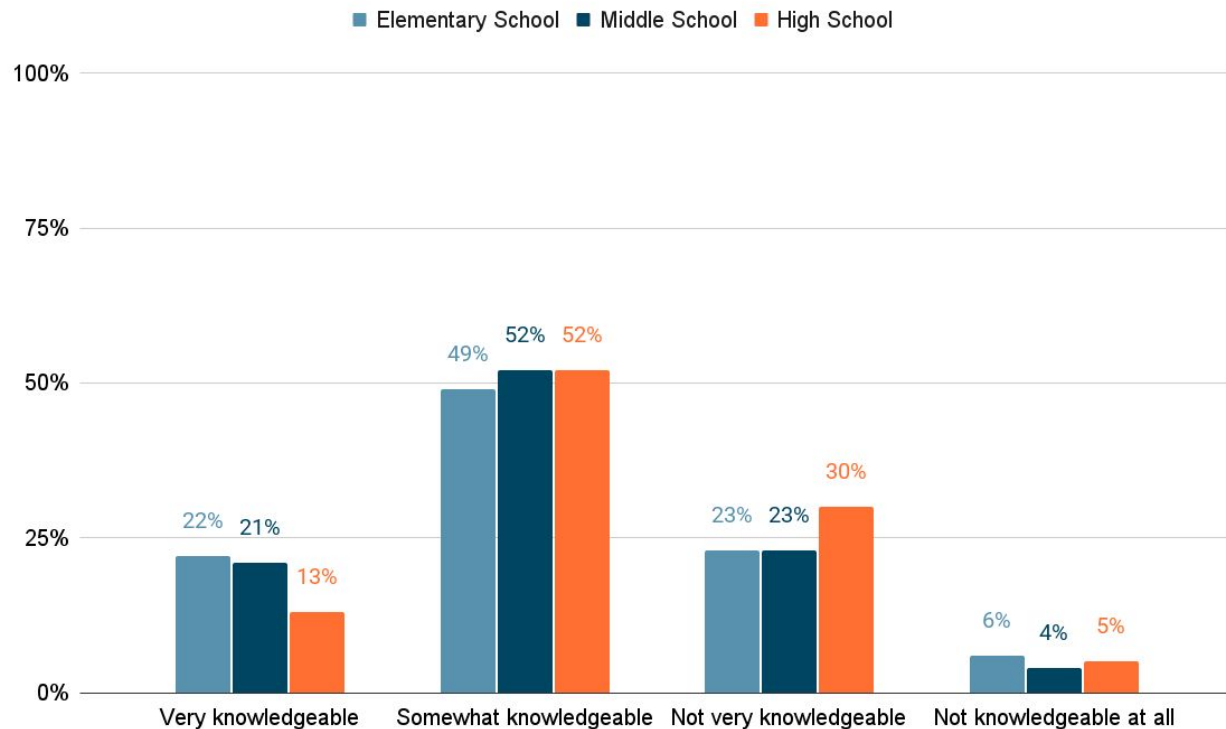

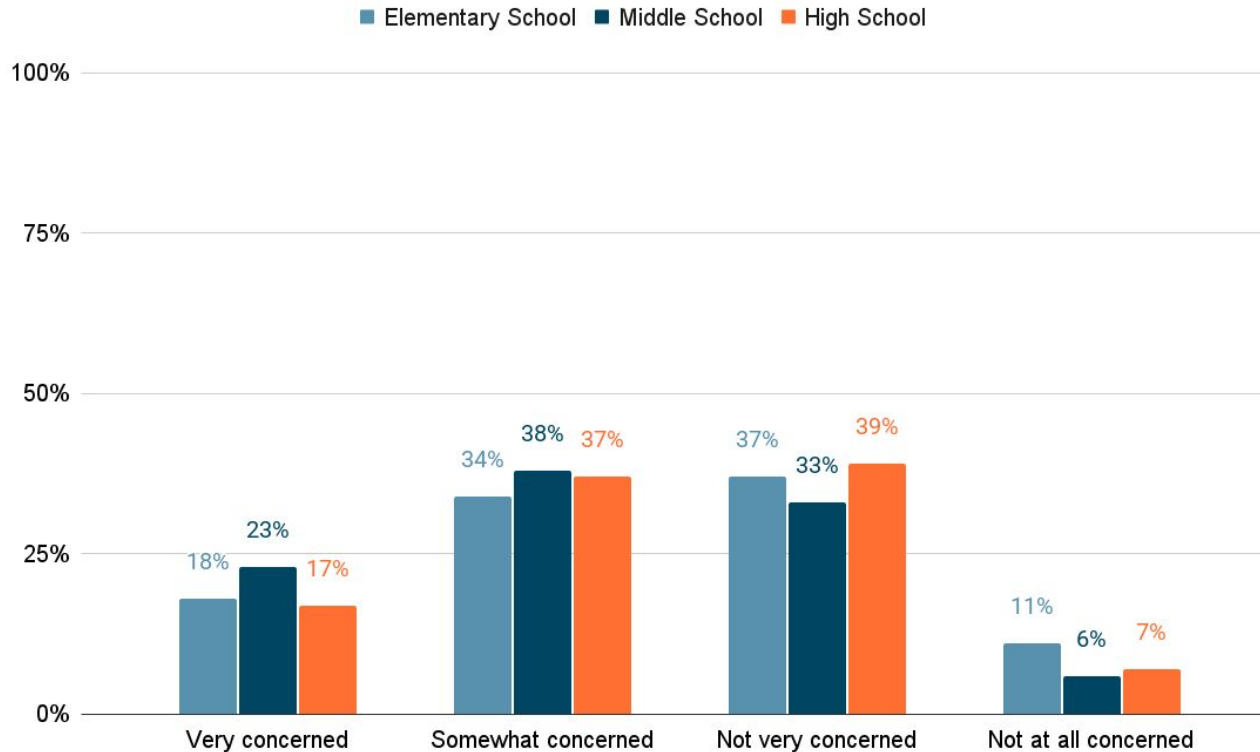

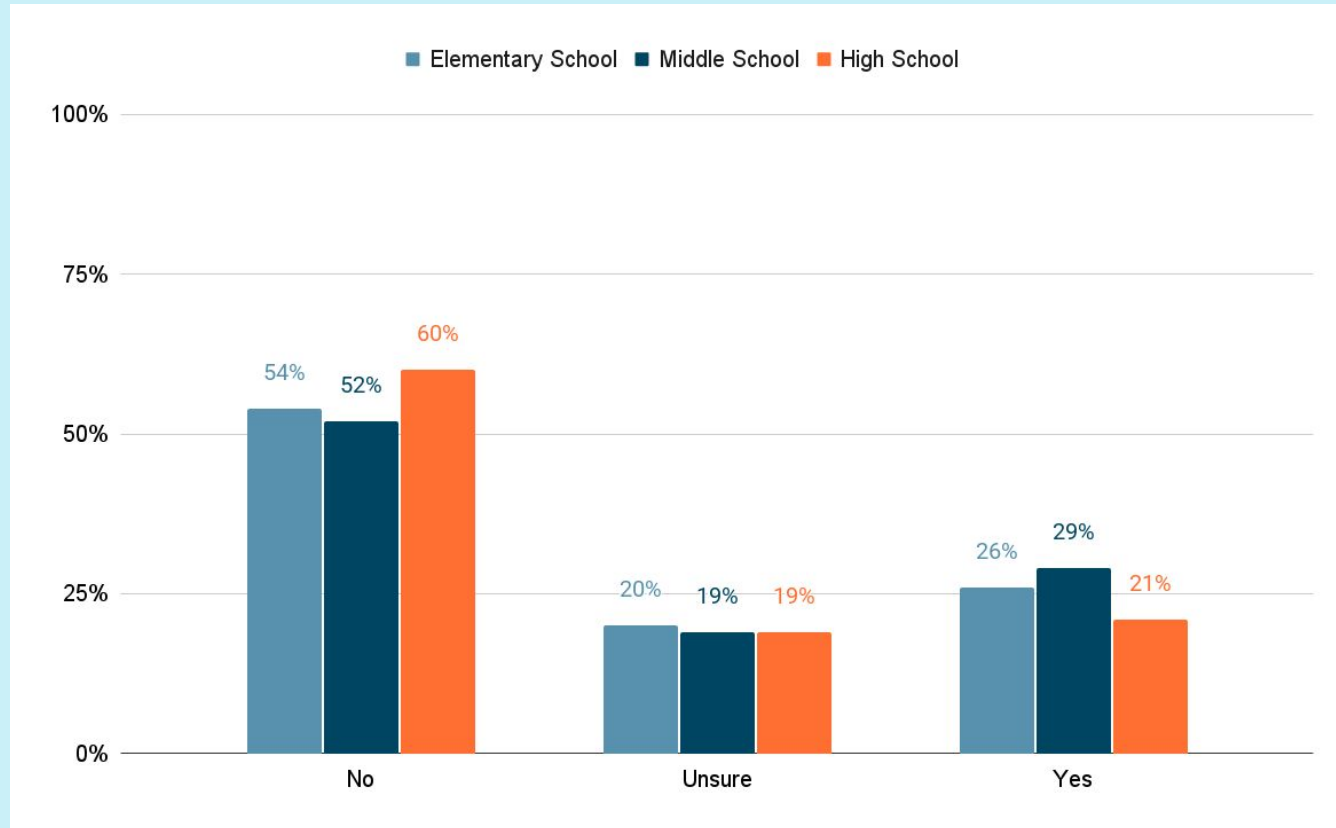

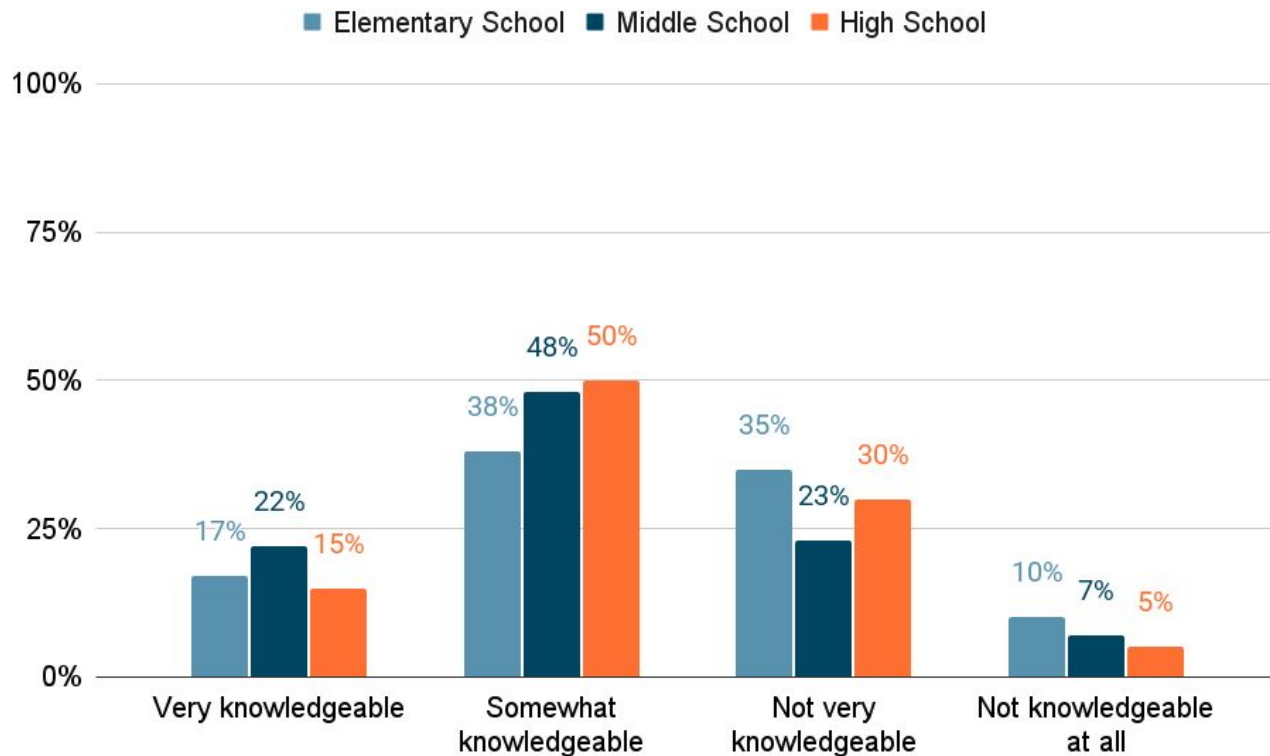

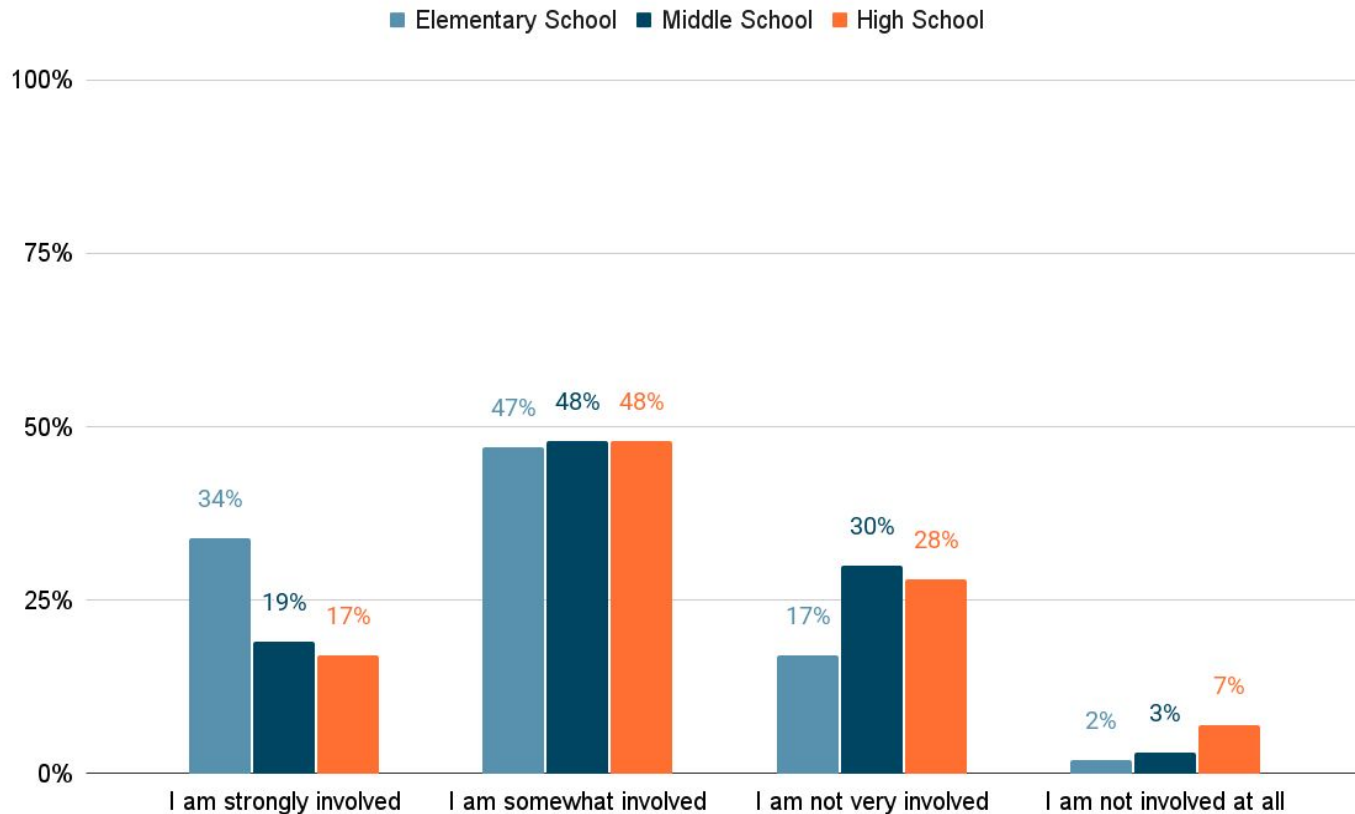

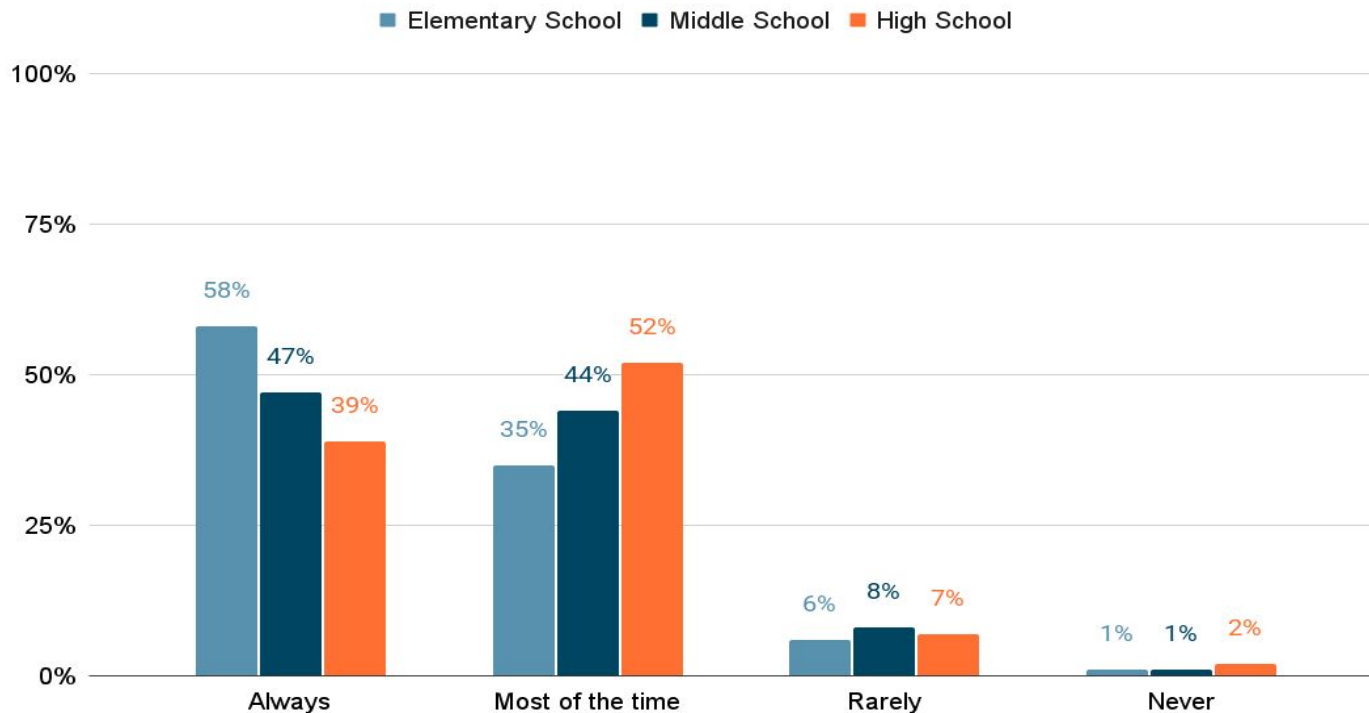

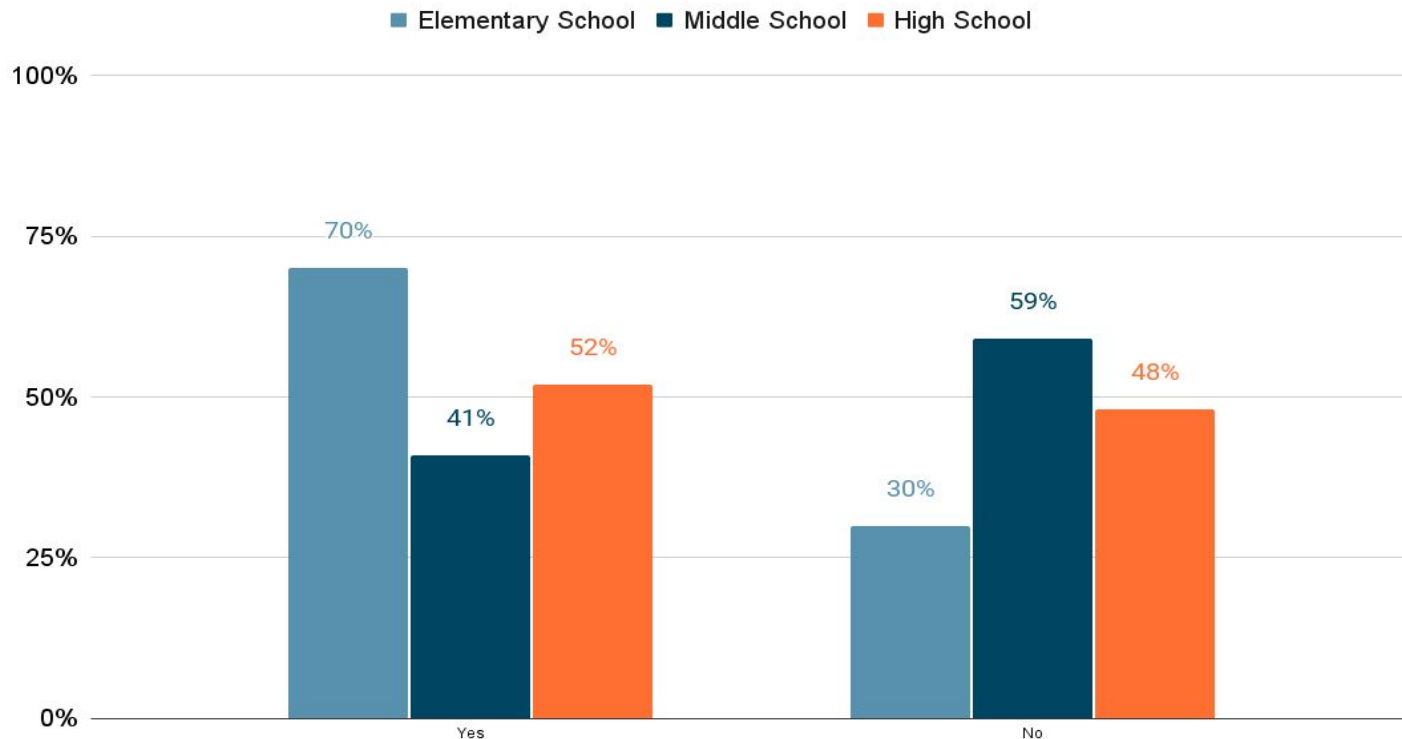

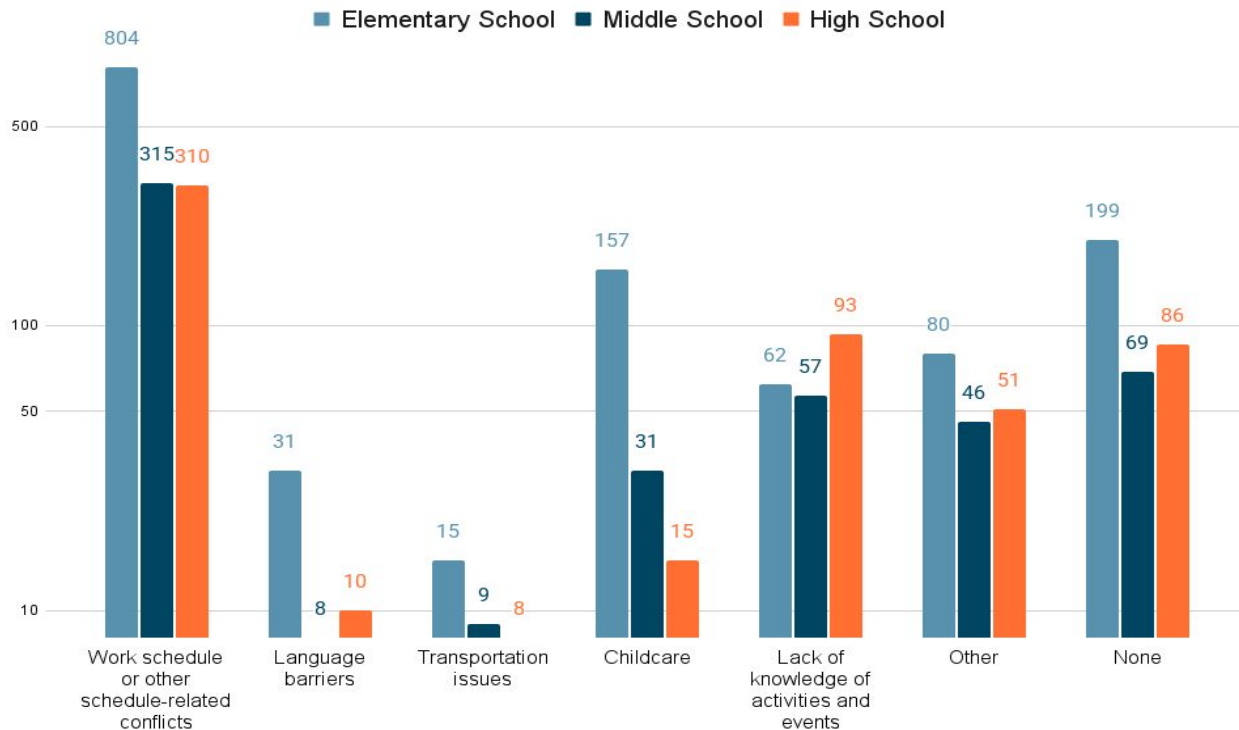

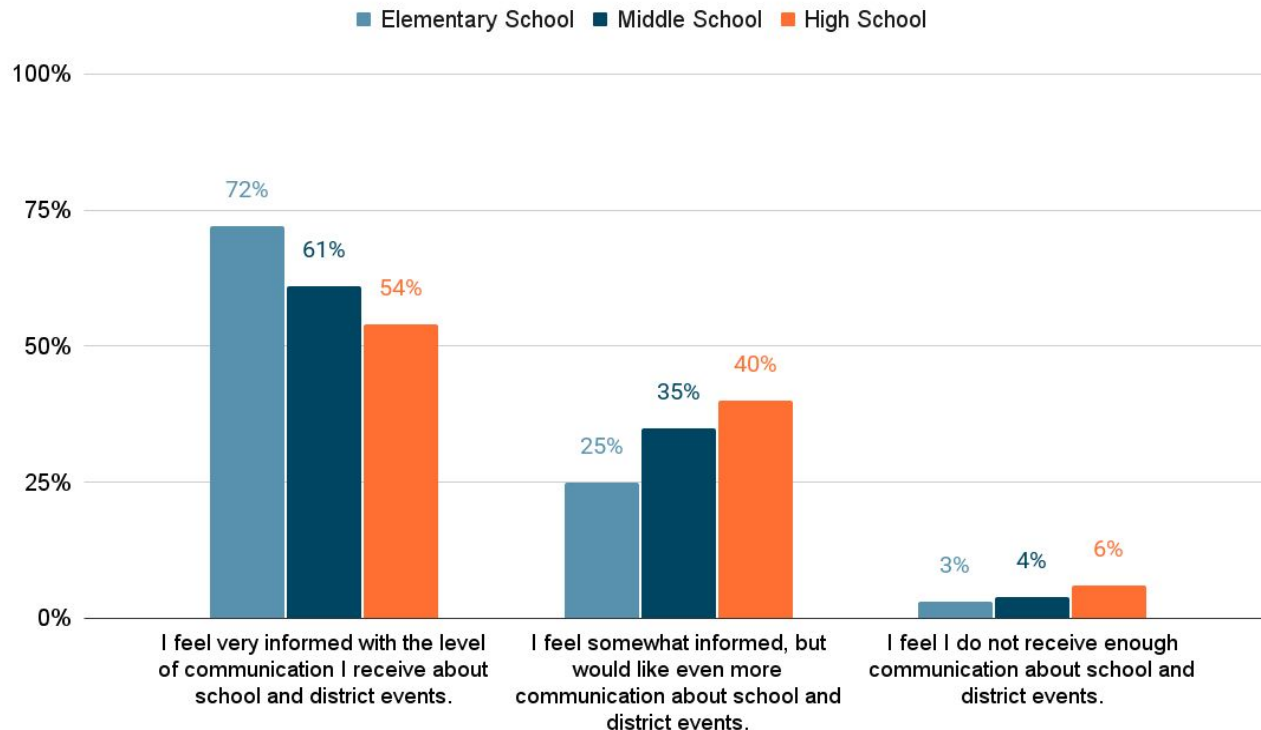

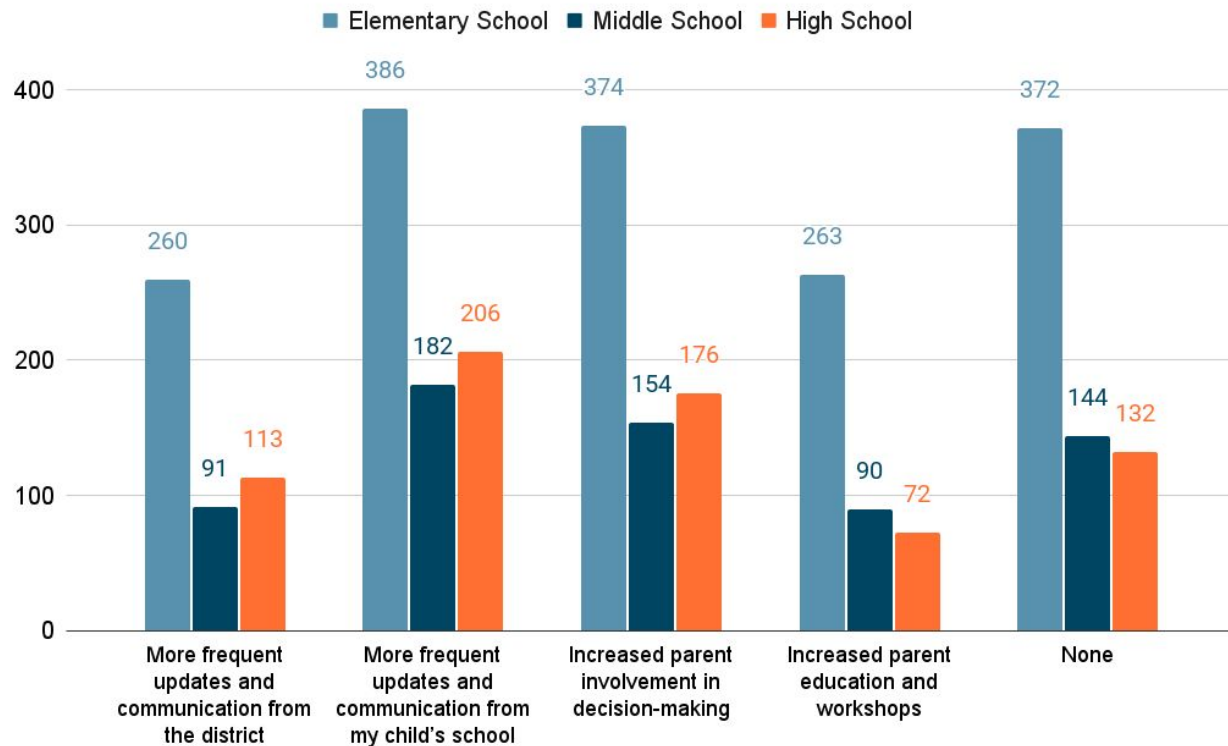

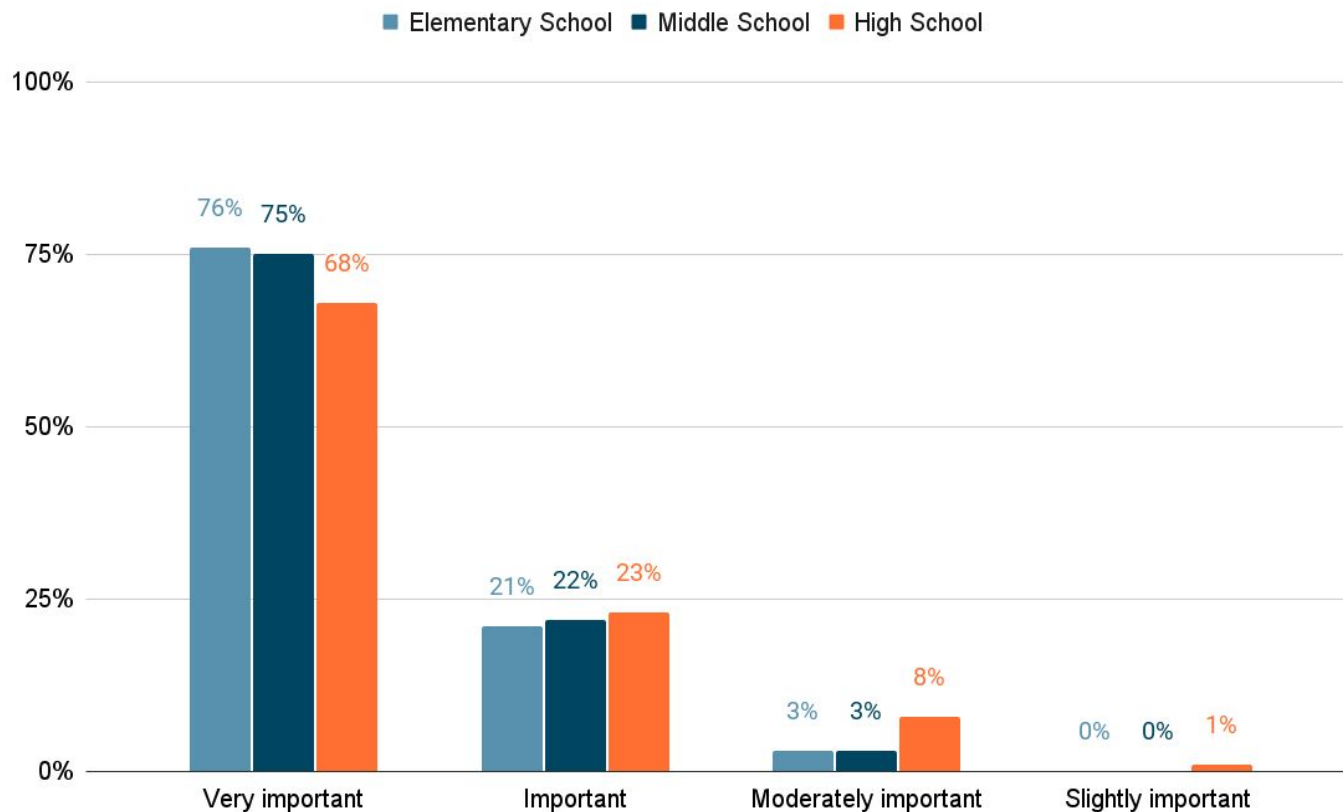
