**4. Student Activities Update,** Brent Mattix & Brandon Fukuman (student gov rep & mascot)

- Student Gov (SG) trained prior to the beginning of the semester; 95% in attendance
- Back to School Night (BTSN) - they helped with set up and guiding parents
- Tiger Cage - increased attendance at sporting events, including attending a game for each sport
- On Friday, SG attended the basketball game against our rival, Woodcreek at home; great spirit! Two of our players got injured.
- Upcoming...
  - Friday, Casaba - rally, walk-out, coronation at halftime of basketball game
  - Saturday, Casaba dance - first time having an ice sculpture (of a tiger); 30% chance of rain; hot inside gym; tickets sales at lunch.
  - Monday - PJ Day; Tuesday, wear Blue & White; Wednesday, Sweater Day; Thursday, Ski theme; Friday, Orange & Black
- Blood Drive - Tuesday, 2/4; must be a minimum of 110 lbs, parental consent needed for age 16 (none needed for age 17+); open to parents. 53 slots. must sign-in. Students can sign up in the cafeteria

- Roseville Bound - 8th graders pick classes; SG will have a booth.
- President's Week (aka Ski Week) - off all week
- Mr. Mattix - Seniors are feeling it! Sober Grad Cruise in the Bay is rolling out.

## 5. College & Career Center Presentation - Jacquie Seider, Coordinator

- Created Scholarship Center room
  - Dedicated an area for Career Assessment - uses the California Career Zone
  - Compare & Contrast careers and wages area
    - free \$300-500 career test - for the military but not exclusively
- In the past, kids were not using CANVAS to work on scholarships during President's Week
- Worked to extend the application time - CANVAS closes on February 14. Open for five weeks, 1/10-2/14/25.
- 365 eligible students to apply for scholarships; 57 have not accepted the course
- A lot of scholarships for ever GPA
- 100% of seniors are getting contacted to be a part of the "program"
- fliers are all over campus to remind students
- RHS typically does better than all the high schools in the RJUHSD; awarded \$141,600 in 2024 (more than all schools in the district put together. Mrs. Seider gives credit to the teachers for allowing her to come into the classrooms to talk to the students, **and** the students doing all the work. We wholeheartedly see all the work Jacquie pours into the programs - she's the GOAT!
- 1600 applications submitted last year from RHS (for reference Oakmont submitted 700).
- Every college-bound student and anyone enlisting, as well as community college, vocational or trade-school.
- Was able to secure 8 more scholarships this year!
- Students can use the scholarships for expenses associated with going to school ( gas, car, computer, etc)
- So many scholarships go unclaimed!
- Personal Essay - AI is not your friend for this essay! 5 elements to consider: Personality, Authenticity, Concrete Examples, Structure, & Goals. Mrs. Seider encourages peer review of the essay.
- Can detailed information on the RHS website under Services...College and Career Services...tutorial.
- Regional and National scholarships deadlines are usually March/April; StudentScholarships.org
- Recommends Juniors to get on to help prepare
- Students and parent input helps to grow the program
  
- Dara to do an e-blast recapping the information and a link.
- Idea - QR Code for Venmo to help fund the popcorn machine (original machine broke; it was a great way to get people in the career center and get familiar, start conversations and ask questions).
- Q&A:
  - of the \$141,600 in scholarships distributed, 147 students applied, 90 received scholarships
  - All military branches have recruiters back!
  - Work Permit - once an offer is made, the student can get approval for a work permit. Encouraged to take it with them to the job interview. The job must have workman's comp.
  - Internship - Terri Griffin with Jacquie - mock interviews, resume writing. FBI teen academy and Umbrella of Health
