The Board Chair, Mr. Boutin, called the Monday, April 7, 2025, meeting to order at 5:05 p.m. at the Barre Social Club, Barre, and via video conference.

3. Additions and/or Deletions with Motion to Approve the Agenda

Add 4.4 Update on Title VI

Mrs. Farrell made a motion, seconded by Mr. Campbell, to approve the agenda with amendments; the motion passed unanimously.

4. Current Business

4.4 Update on Title VI - (taken out of order) Email from Secretary Saunders asking school districts to review and sign an assurance related to Title VI by this Thursday afternoon. Requested by the Federal Government, and if we didn't sign, the idea was that we would not receive, as a state, the Title I funds. The superintendent recommends that the board sit tight before any action is taken.

4.1. VoIP Recommendation Approval / Barre Town Stormwater Approval

Recommended phone system.

BT Stormwater approval for \$26,000

Ms. Wheeler Reynolds made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Farrell, to approve the superintendent's recommendation to enter into a three-year contract with Broadvoice for phone services; the motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Wheeler Reynolds made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Wheeler, to approve the superintendent's recommendation to use K Bellavance Land Works for the stormwater project at BTMES. BUUSD share is 10%, and the board approves \$26,995 to be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund; the motion passed unanimously.

Concerns were raised about the estimate due to the inflated cost of other projects with this company. This is under a bid and contract, and any change will be returned to the board.
