- ♥ Come visit our playground this summer!

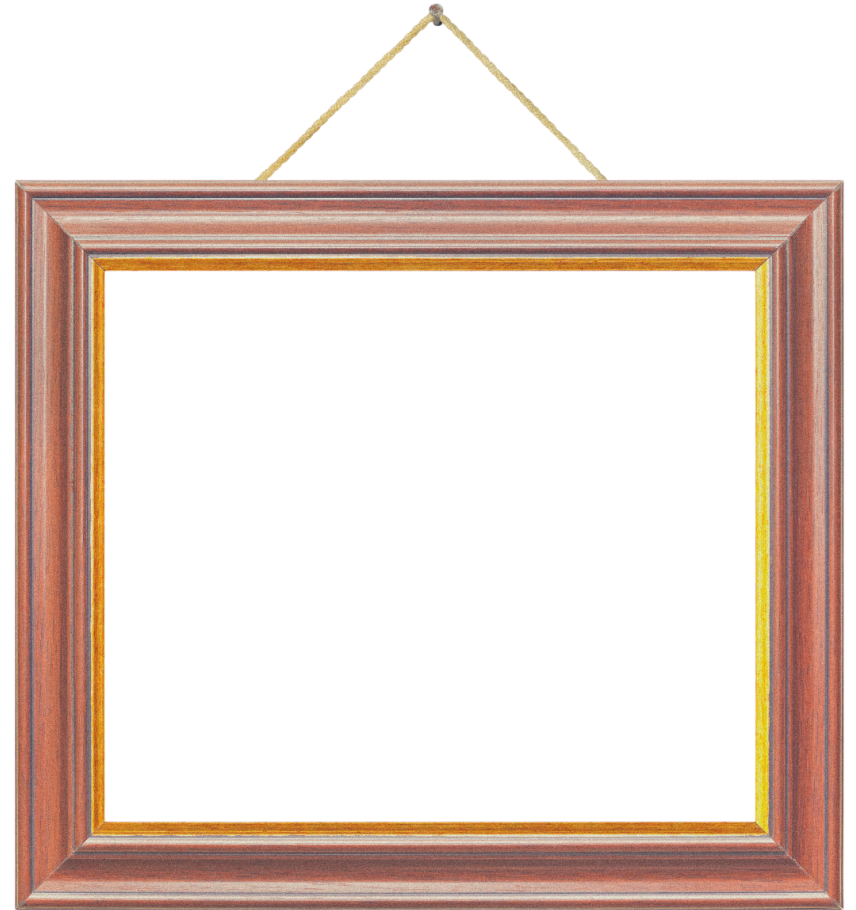
