The Early College Program is for qualified high school students taking college-level courses with the opportunity to earn a high school diploma, Associate Arts Degree, and/or transferable credit towards the University of California and/or California State University systems.

Student Goals:

1. Academic success in high school and college courses.

3. Prepare for transfer to a four-year college or university.
4. Enrollment in a four-year college or university after the *Early College Program*.

Student Responsibilities:

1. Commit to the Early College Program for the entire 4 years of high school.
2. Maintain satisfactory grades and attendance.
3. Abide by the San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC) Student Code of Conduct.
4. Participate in on-going advisement with your Bloomington and SBVC counselor.
5. Complete all assignments, readings, and exams.
6. Successfully complete schedules SBVC courses each semester.

1. Regularly monitor transcripts and progress reports.
2. Assist student with four-year college awareness, research, and preparedness.

Student Agreement:

I agree to accept enrollment into the *Early College Program* at Bloomington, Colton, or Grand Terrace High School, whereby I will take approved dual enrollment courses taught by San Bernardino Valley College instructors. I will begin the program in **Fall 2024**. I understand that I will be scheduled into San Bernardino Valley College courses periods 0 & 7 and take a minimum of four classes through the Colton Joint Unified School District. I understand I may be required to attend intersession programs prior to winter break and at the conclusion of the academic year. I understand that I may have the option to take Early College courses on campus at San Bernardino Valley College during my Senior year.

Authorization to Release Student Information

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) regulates the disclosure of confidential educational information.
