- **Founder's report (Najine)** : Been having a lot of conversations with 6th, 7th, and 8th grade families regarding the closing and consolidation of schools, encouraging families to see the positive benefits of these changes. It is important to understand the IB program (at Montgomery HS) and its importance to the French curriculum.

- **PAF Report (Ben)** : Carnival raised \$50,000. - The dessert auction was fun and a huge success! Planning has already started for the 2026 Carnival (April 4 at Vintners Inn). The talent show was excellent. Middle schoolers have been fundraising for their trip to France in June 2025. Dine-and-Donate, Earth Day activities, Kremesse, picnics, and Staff, SAB, and PAF appreciation dinner are among the various activities coming up!

- **Certificated (Sharon)** : Two teachers who received pink slips, but those have been rescinded.

- **TOSA Report (Ketsia)** : DELF testing is coming - 4 levels will be tested. Congratulations to our Middle schoolers who participated in Public Speaking events in San Francisco and Boston. They did a fantastic job. And thank you, PAF, for funding the trip. This is very valuable for our students, and we would like to continue Public Speaking project, but not with Eloquentia.
