Language Arts Learning Goals:

Big Idea: "Why do the Sun and Moon capture our imagination?"

Amazing Words: observe, space, telescope, Earth, wonder, planet, star, Moon

- *Heart words: I'm, going, want, right, what, light, play, better, after, move, during, from, night, out, goes, coming, away
- *decode words with /or/ as in for, corn, score, board
- *comprehension: I can recall information from a nonfiction text
- *identify the main idea of a text
- *differentiate between fiction and nonfiction text
- *ask and answer questions from a text
- *take notes from a nonfiction text
- *read nonfiction text and recall information
- *use text features to better understand a text
- *review /ar/ words

Math Learning Goals:

- *understand how many tens are in decade numbers (40 has 4 tens)
- *mentally add and subtract tens to 2 digit numbers (36+40=76 or 98-50=48)
- *mentally add or subtract 10 to any number up to 99
- *understand two-digit numbers as tens and ones (67= 6 tens and 7 ones)
- *build math fact fluency to 20
- *add single digit numbers to 2 digit numbers by counting on
- *add double digit numbers with and without regrouping

Science and Health Learning Goals:

- *compare and contrast the day and night sky
- *understand and model what causes day and night
- *take notes about the Earth
- *understand and model what causes the seasons
- *take notes about the Moon
- *vocabulary: day, night, rotate, orbit, revolve, year, seasons, axis, tilt, Earth, Moon, crater
