**Notice to Parents, Guardians, and Staff
Glen Cove City School District
Lead in School Drinking Water Sampling Scheduled
04/23/25-04/24/25-04/25/25**

Per the New York State Department of Health Lead in Water regulation, Glen Cove City School District will complete the districtwide water testing for the 2023-2025 compliance period on 04/23/25-04/24/25-04/25/25. Any water outlets that are used for drinking or food preparation will be tested. Other outlets that are used for handwashing and dishwashing only, will have a sign posted noting this. The sampling will be done in the early morning hours before the school's are open and will not impact activities at the school. Our goal is to comply with the regulation and provide safe drinking water sources throughout all its facilities. If lead is found at any water outlet at levels above 5 parts per billion (ppb), which is equal to 5 micrograms per liter ($\mu\text{g/L}$), the outlet will be removed from service until remediation is complete. A letter will be sent out to Parents, Guardians and Staff notifying them of the results within 10 days of the sampling event. The full report, including any remediation efforts that may take place, will be posted on our district website when all sampling activities are complete.
