



Customized Professional Learning



Teaching students who are deaf/hard of hearing (DHH) and dual-sensory impaired (DSI) requires highly specialized training. This population of students is low incidence and requires a certified teacher of the deaf/hard of hearing (TODHH) to provide [specially designed instruction](#) by way of the [Expanded Skills Standards](#), targeted communication strategies, and evidence-based literacy interventions developed specifically for students who are DHH.

Many districts may not have a sufficient number of TODHHs to justify the cost of bringing in external experts to provide this specialized professional learning (PL). In addition, the professional learning needs of TODHHs often shift as student rosters change throughout the year and from year to year. Timely and flexible access to professional learning opportunities becomes essential.

RMTC-DHH offers a wide range of no-cost [PL opportunities](#), both online and in-person, to stakeholders across Florida. This document offers a curated list of additional professional learning opportunities specifically focused on serving students who are DHH and DSI—accessible anytime, from anywhere.

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
