We are looking for an experienced Multi Skilled Tradesperson to join our Maintenance team who undertake the day-to-day internal and external maintenance, and repair and upkeep of the Royal Russell Estate in South London. The team also undertake major refurbishment and upgrading projects throughout the school buildings including the School's boarding facilities.

You will be hard working, reliable, organised and motivated and hold a trade qualification in carpentry and joinery (C&G, NVQ or equivalent). Previous work experience in multi-trade building and maintenance works, along with a full, clean, driving licence are desirable, but not essential. A strong work ethic, a can-do attitude, and a willingness to pitch in to help colleagues are essential. You should also have a knowledge of health and safety requirements.

Members of the maintenance team also need to be able to use their initiative to ensure that their daily tasks are completed to the highest standards, and to have a flexible approach whether working unsupervised or as part of the wider team.

Key Responsibilities

The Multi Skilled Tradesperson undertakes proactive day-to-day repairs around the School estate, including, school buildings and staff houses, carrying out refurbishment projects as required as part of the maintenance team.

Duties:

Carry out proactive and reactive remedial carpentry, plumbing, roofing etc. works as required, in support of the maintenance team or planned preventative maintenance team.

Support the wider maintenance team in ensuring that the Royal Russell estate, including St David's Prep School (Purley) is always maintained to the highest level – identifying and proactively rectifying issues.

Undertake planned carpentry works as part of the maintenance team projects.

Undertake minor building works with respect to all trades (redecoration, dry lining, groundworks etc.)

Advising on need for specialist equipment and tools.

Liaise with Projects & Maintenance Supervisor on timings and work to be completed. Ensure reasonable protection to materials and property during the works.

Respond to daily to requests from staff regarding alterations and repairs in classrooms, boarding accommodation, day houses, and staff properties. This includes general problems relating to health and safety issues and covers plumbing, drainage, sewage, heating, electrics and other repair work.

Liaise with staff and occupants of properties to ensure adequate consultation and minimum of disruption when carrying out maintenance works.

Be aware and observe any opportunity to reduce costs and improve standards and ensure those ideas are shared with the maintenance team.



Key Responsibilities

Health and Safety:

Ensuring adherence and compliance of yourself and all staff working on projects to Health & Safety legislation and all departmental policies and procedures, to ensure the safety of yourself and colleagues as well as pupils, staff and visitors.

Be willing to undertake training and refresher courses as necessary and acquire associated trade skills.

Advise the Projects & Maintenance Supervisor / Estates Manager of any breaches in health and safety.

Participate in and contribute to health and safety risk assessments and method statements relating to the maintenance team.

Ensure safe use of equipment; observe warnings and directions for use of materials and equipment.

Ensure that task appropriate PPE is worn.

Ensure reasonable protection to materials and property during the works.

Erection of scaffolding/ladders in a prescribed safe manner as required enabling works to be carried out.

Other responsibilities:

Ensure the safety and well being of children and young people at the School by adhering to and always complying with the School's Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy.

Ensure correct staff identification is always worn whilst on site and that you clock in and out to ensure good time keeping.

Dress appropriately and in a professional manner, and always wear correct uniform.

Attend Royal Russell Day and Open Day as required.

Attend training and staff INSET sessions organised by the School to provide a consistent approach across the entire School staff population.

Undertake the Schools' performance management/appraisal process.

Be a First Aider.

Be willing to undertake training as necessary and acquire associated trade skills.

Be part of the school's call-out service to provide out of hours cover (for additional payments.)

Carry out any other duties as reasonably requested by Projects and Maintenance Supervisor and Estates Manager.
