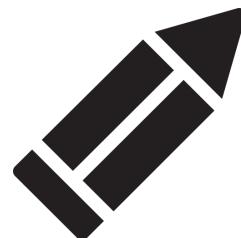

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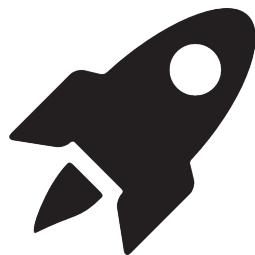
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Math-By-Mail (Entering Gr. K-6)

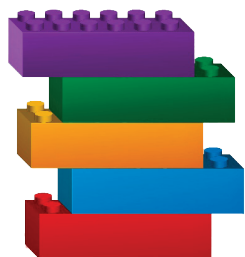

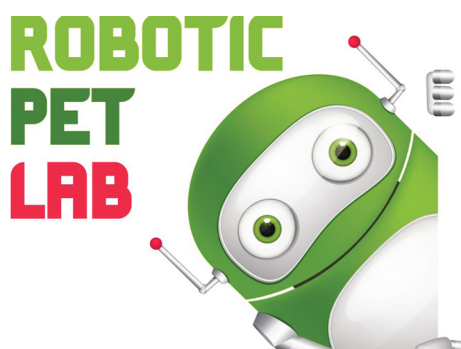

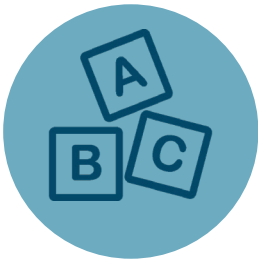
