

Technical Interim Amendment District Master Specification SECTION 26 05 33 ELECTRICAL SYSTEM RACEWAY and BOXES 2023 Edition

PART 2 PRODUCTS

2.9 FLOOR BOXES

- A. Floor Boxes: GENERALLY NOT ALLOWED
- B. When permitted, in writing from the District;
 - 1. <u>Use cast iron floor boxes or nonmetallic floor boxes for installations in slab on grade; formed steel boxes are acceptable for other installations.</u>
 - 2. In meeting rooms (measuring at least 12' wide with a floor area of at least 215 square feet), stub up conduit and box with outlet in the location of the conference table leg furthest from the screen / smart board. (NEC 210.65)
 - 3. Do not use floor boxes for feed through wiring except to another floor box.
 - 4. Set floor boxes level.
 - 5. Adjust floor box flush with flinish flooring material.

PART 3 EXECUTION 3.2 INSTALLATION - BOXES

- Q. Use cast iron floor boxes or nonmetallic floor boxes for installations in slab on grade; formed steel boxes are acceptable for other installations.
- R. Set floor boxes level.
- T. Do not use floor boxes for feed through wiring except to another floor box.

3.4 ADJUSTING

A. Adjust floor box flush with finish flooring material.
