 $\star$  From the nurse's office: Head lice checks: Weekly home routine encouraged

Head lice are a common problem among elementary children so weekly hair checks should become a regular routine with hair hygiene. Head lice can crawl from head to head when children play or work closely together. It is much easier to get rid of a head lice infestation if it is caught early. In addition to routine checks, it is a good idea to check your child's head before and after attending a sleepover.

Head lice can be a nuisance but they have not been shown to spread disease. Personal hygiene or cleanliness in the home or school has nothing to do with getting head lice. For more information visit the D5 website School Health Services page or contact your school nurse.
